这本书讲的是什么？

一起聊一聊

首先和孩子一起看看封面，并读出上面的英文书名。然后一起讨论封面上的图片，让孩子说一说故事可能会讲些什么，并和孩子一起快速浏览故事，根据图片猜猜发生了什么事情。最后翻到第 2 ~ 3 页，将图片中的角色和文本中的名字连起来。

读一读

- 鼓励孩子大声朗读故事，您也可以和孩子一起朗读，享受阅读的乐趣。
- 如果孩子读错了，就让孩子重读这句话，然后检查这次读得是否正确。但不要让孩子重读的时间过长，以免影响对故事的整体感觉。
- 读到第 8 页时，问孩子：How would you ask me for a samosa if you were really hungry? 然后鼓励孩子有感情地朗读该页上的对话。
- 读到第 9 页时，让孩子数一数图片中有几个三角饺，看看孩子能不能正确地读出单词 eight。
- 问问孩子最喜欢故事的哪一部分，并鼓励孩子再读一遍。

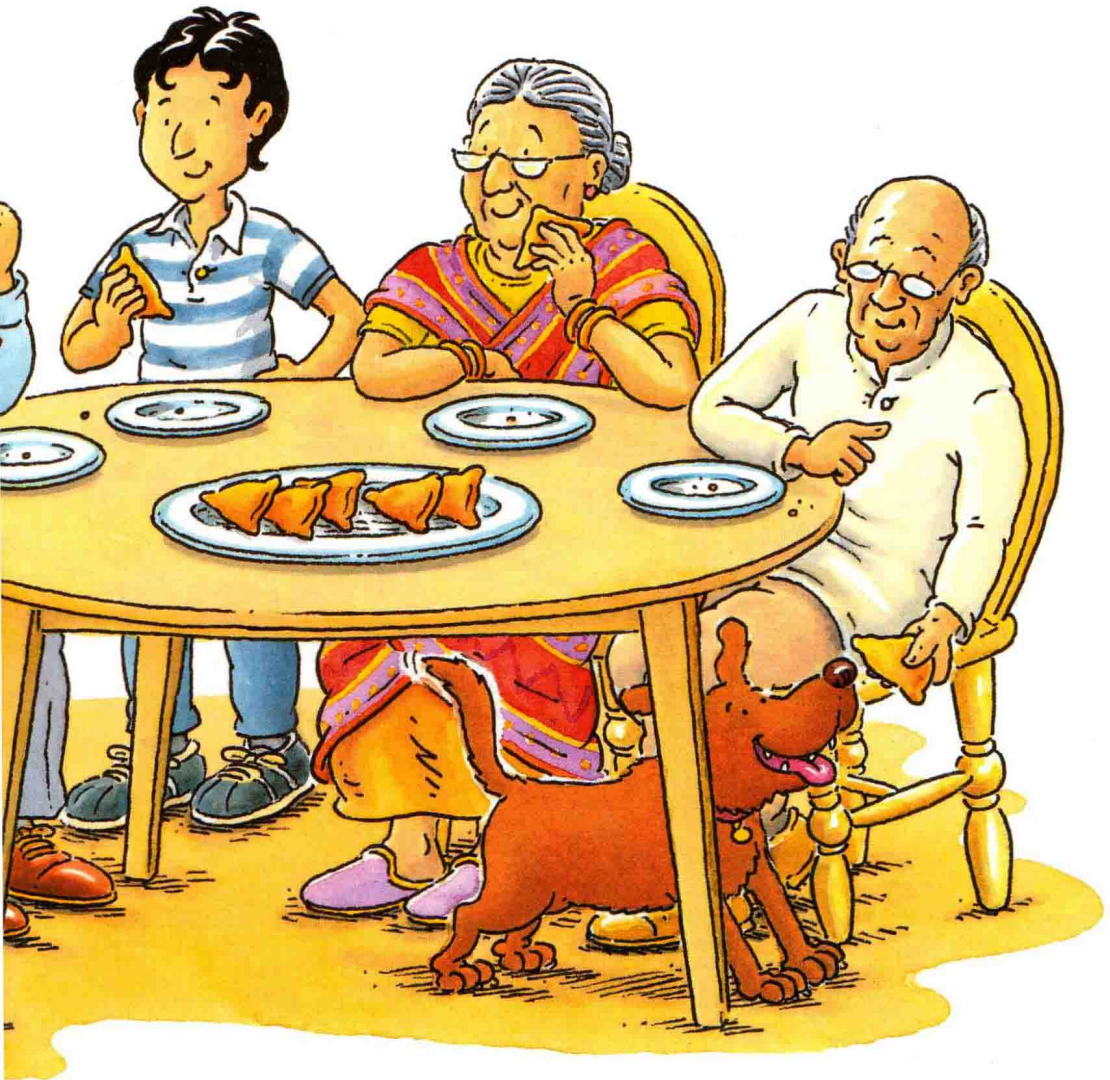

The window was open, and the twins could smell the samosas cooking. Benji could smell them too. His nose was twitching!

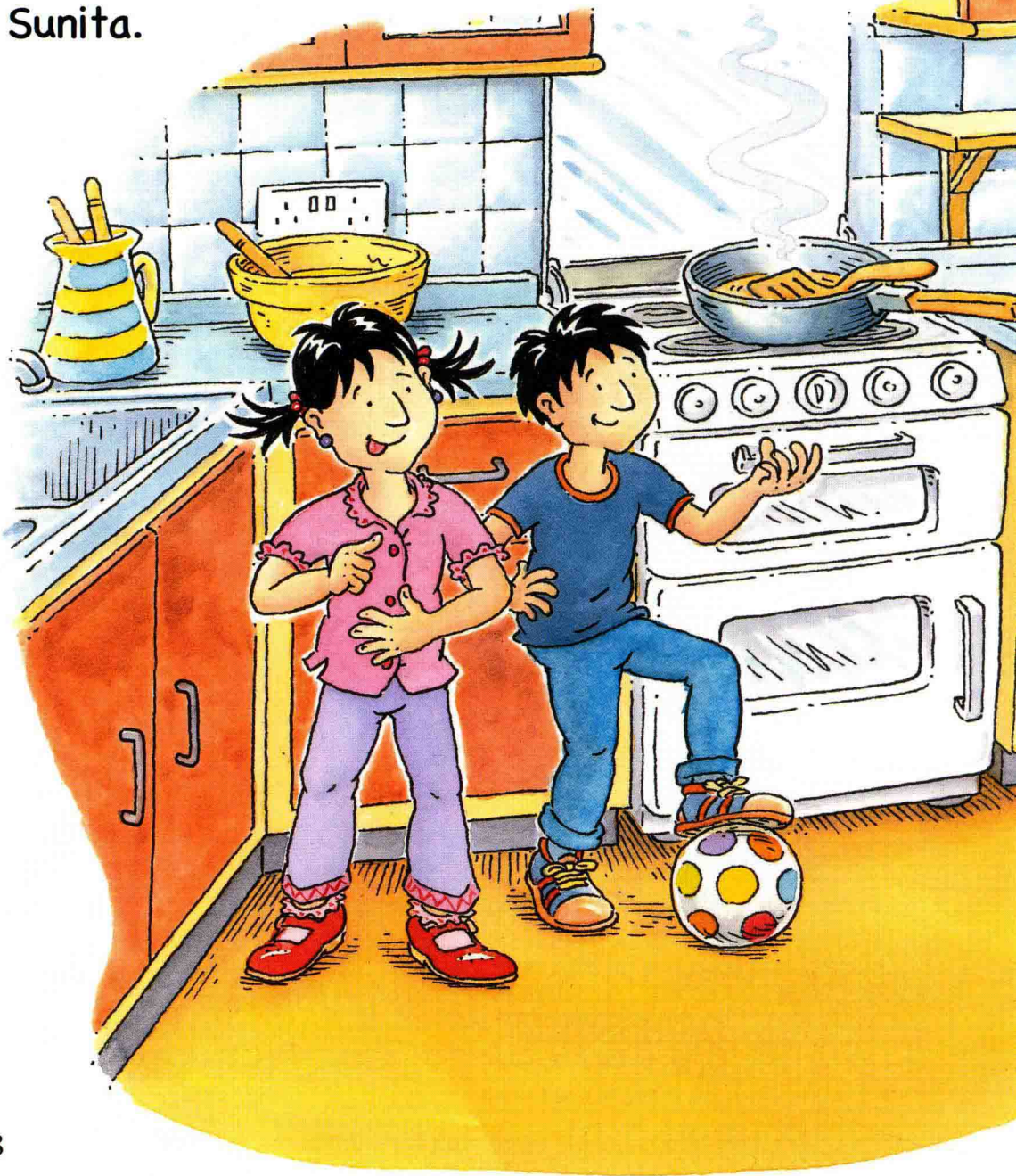
Sunita and Sanjay were very hungry. They ran into the kitchen and asked Mum if they could have a samosa.

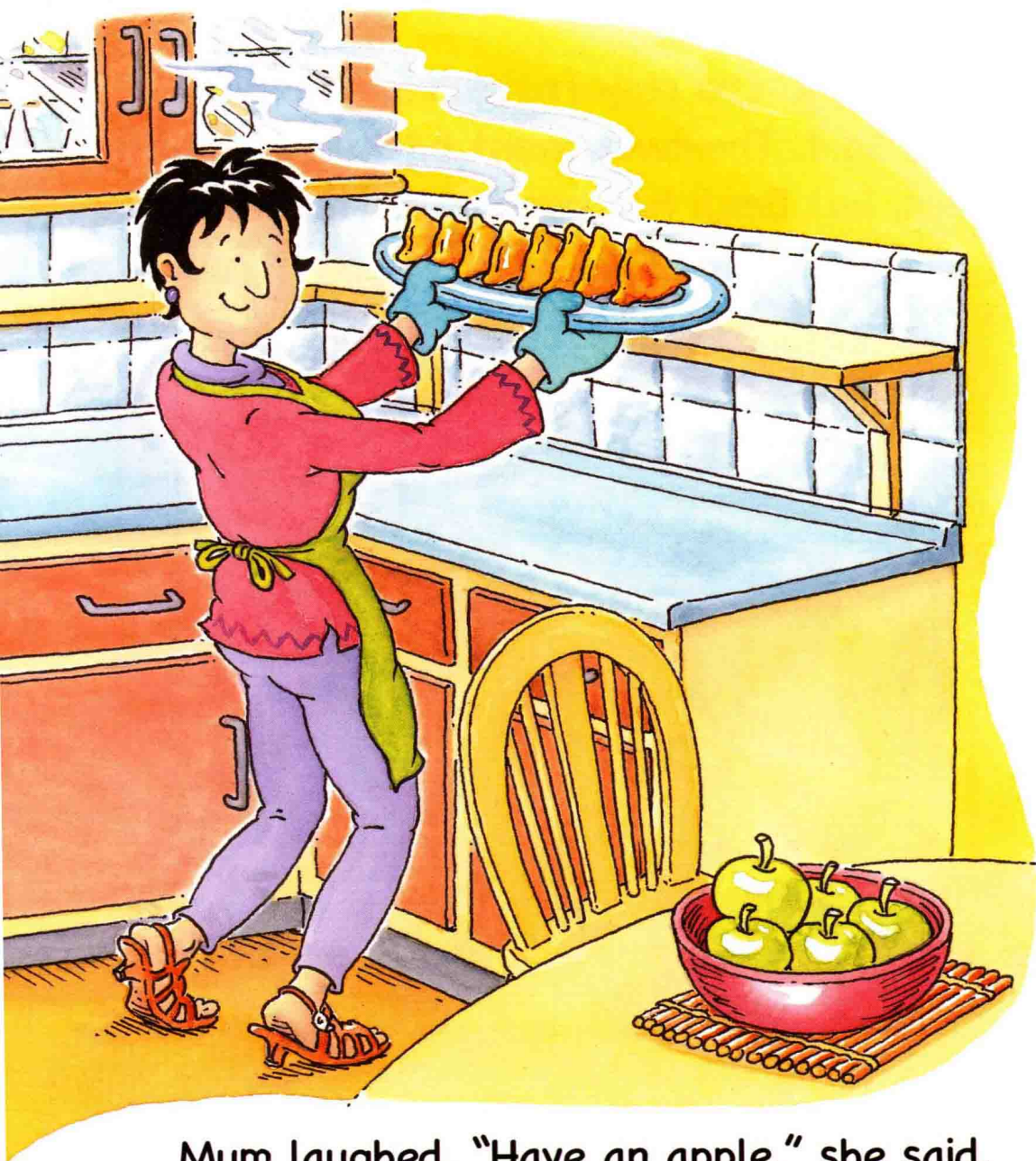


"Not yet," Mum replied. "You'll have to wait until they cool down a bit."
