

内容提要

本书为美国得克萨斯大学西南医学中心整形外科住院医师规范化培训手册。全书分为整形外科基础,皮肤和软组织,头颈部,乳房,躯干和下肢,手、腕和上肢,美容手术7个部分,基本涵盖整形外科常见疾病的治疗,另附大量精美插图与表格,极大地丰富了本书内容。全书采用树状提纲格式,详列要点,条理清晰,每章都用不同颜色标出提示、警告、要点等重点内容,方便快速查询与记忆。本书融合了近期文献中发表的最新概念,代表了相关领域内的最新进展;参考文献详尽,方便读者进行拓展阅读。本书适用于医学生、住院医师、进修医师等在较短时间内快速掌握整形外科基础;整形外科住院医师规范化培训;整形外科短期进修培训;烧伤科、骨科、手外科、普通外科、胸外科、乳腺外科、头颈外科、颌面外科、神经外科等相关学科人员快速深入了解本学科修复重建专业知识和技术。

这个手册不是一本涵盖整个整形外科的、放在书柜中的参考书。它的目的是带给读者最为"精要"的内容,并提供宝贵的整形外科基础。它包括 88 个问题,分成 7 个部分:整形外科基础,皮肤和软组织,头颈部,乳房,躯干和下肢,手、腕和上肢,美容手术。其中的绝大部分内容都是由达拉斯的得克萨斯大学西南医学中心整形外科的住院医师和进修医师们完成。所有的作者都花费了大量的时间和精力来保证各自章节的完整性和可读性。

作为一名毕业不久的住院医师和终身的学生,我觉得我能很好地抓住关键部分,从而使得这本手册发挥其最大功用。我尝试着将这些要素融入本书中。首先,必须让这本书能很容易地放进白大褂的口袋中。为达到这个目标,我们控制了书的大小和页数,甚至还为此专门测量了白大褂的口袋尺寸。为明白无误地传递信息,全书采用了统一的带项目符号的提纲格式,并配上大量的图解和表格。本书还采用了第二种颜色来增强信息显示。每个章节都有提示,提供一些不一定出现在教科书或文献中的理解和实用的建议。每个章节结束部分都有要点,可以向读者提供快速的信息源和帮助复习本章节中的要点。最后,参考文献可以让读者查找到原始文献对特定的内容进行深入阅读。总的来说,这本书特意设计成一本"全能"的手册:版式新颖、查看方便、内容明确。

为提升整个项目水平,我们还计划将此手册的内容做成电子格式以用于笔记本和桌上型电脑,还有 Palm 手机和掌上电脑等。

我希望这本书能在医学生和专业人员的口袋中找到它的位置。如果有一天您 发现您的书已经被翻得有些破损,书上标着密密麻麻的注释,那就说明这本书实 现了它的价值。

译者前言
