编写说明

大学英语教学改革是高等学校教学改革的重要组成部分。教育部制定的《大学英语课程教学要求》将大学英语的教学目标确定为:"培养学生英语综合应用能力,特别是听说能力,使他们在今后工作和社会交往中能用英语有效地进行口头和书面的信息交流。同时增强其自主学习能力,提高其综合文化素养,以适应我国经济发展和国际交流的需要。"据此,我们编写了本书,作为大学英语听力辅助教材,旨在通过自主学习提高广大高校学生及英语爱好者的听力水平。

听力是多种能力的综合,它不仅与听者的基本听力技能有关,而且与 听者的英语基本功和知识面有密切的联系。扎实的语言基本功,良好的听 力习惯,高超的听力技巧和对有关学科的背景知识的了解是提高听力的关 键。

全书共分 20 个单元,内容为人们日常生活及语言交际中常用的话题以及一些英美概况知识。第 1 - 10 单元主要侧重听力基本功的训练。通过这一阶段的听力训练,可以提高听者的听音、辨音、听音会意、对语流反应的自动性,以及形成语感和英语思维习惯等;第 11 - 20 单元则侧重提高整体听力理解水平,所选题型均为四、六级常考题型。同时为扩大知识面,书中增加了一些英语文化背景知识。

本书在编写过程中注重循序渐进,同时体现时代性,是广大英语学习 爱好者提高英语听说水平的实用教材,可供大学生及其他英语爱好者学习 使用。

本书在编写过程中受到了华中科技大学张金泉教授、南昌大学赵国杰教授及北京王长喜老师的精心指导,同时九江学院外语系全体教师给予了极大的支持,在此一并表示感谢。

由于编者水平有限、时间仓促、缺乏经验,在选材、编写中难免存在缺点和错误,衷心欢迎广大读者及专家批评指正并提出宝贵意见。
