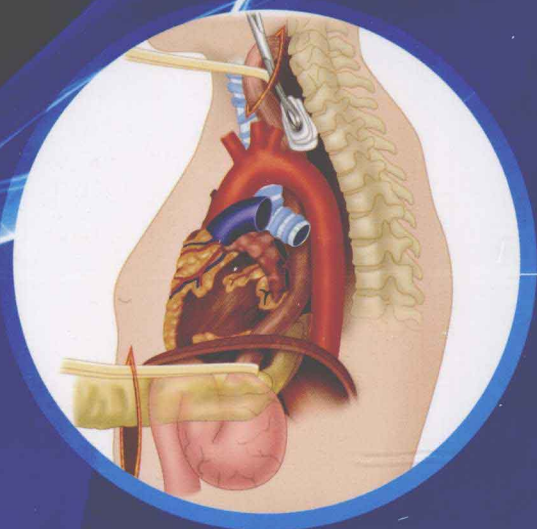

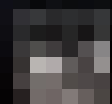


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Atlas of Thoracic Surgical Techniques

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译者前言

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原著前言

当代外科与 20 年前相比发生了翻天覆地的变化。科学技术和手术技巧的新进展使外科医生可以通过微小切口完成大型手术，既减轻了患者的痛苦，也缩短了住院时间。即便如此，手术过程还是常伴随紧迫感，因为外科医生手中掌握着患者生存的机会和希望。可以说，外科手术既是一门科学，又是一门艺术。一个成功的外科医生应该两者兼备，这就要求外科医生不但要能精准地运用大量精细的外科手术工具和器械，还要与时俱进，学习最前沿的医学科学和技术的发展成果。
