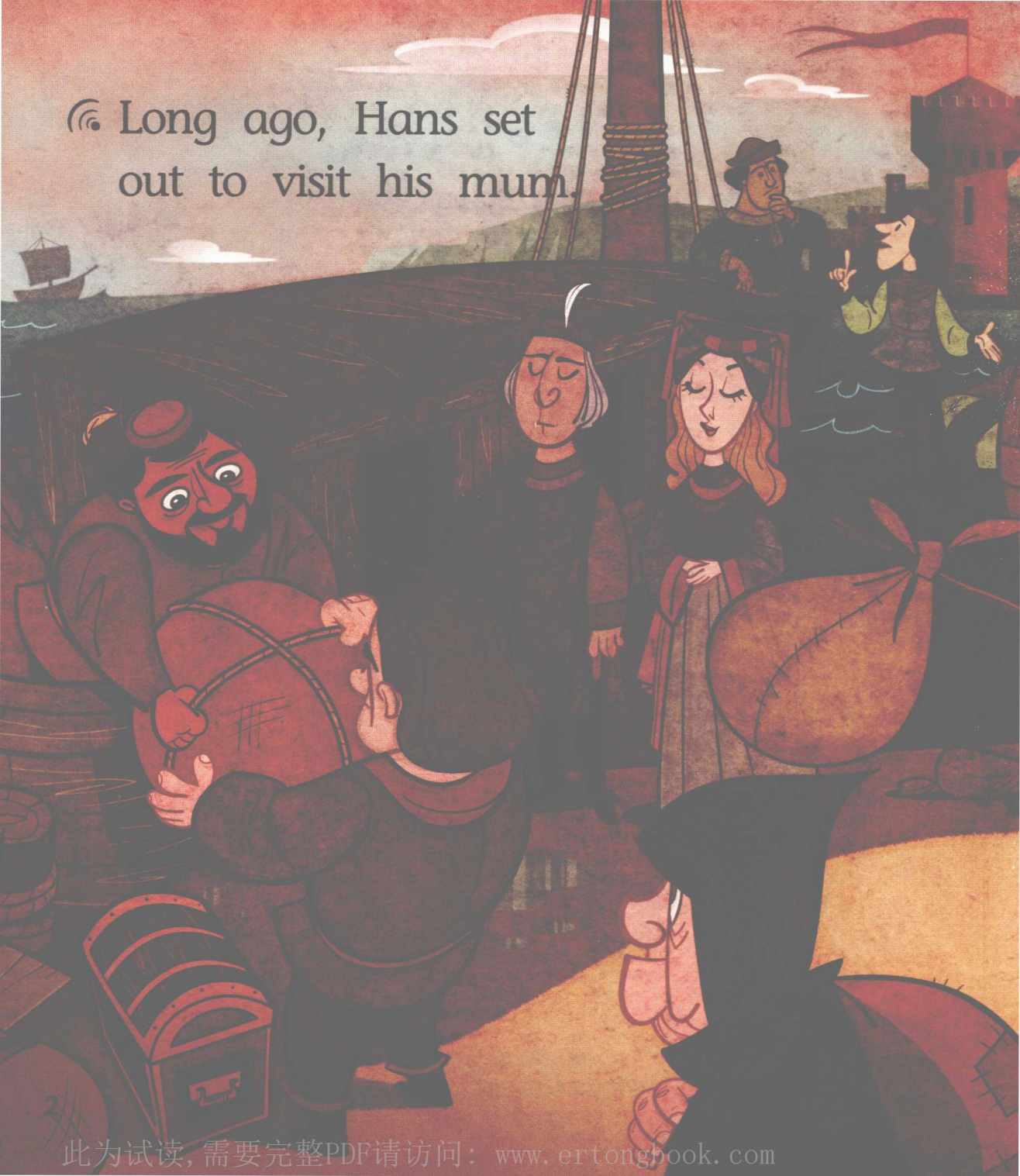

out to visit his mum.











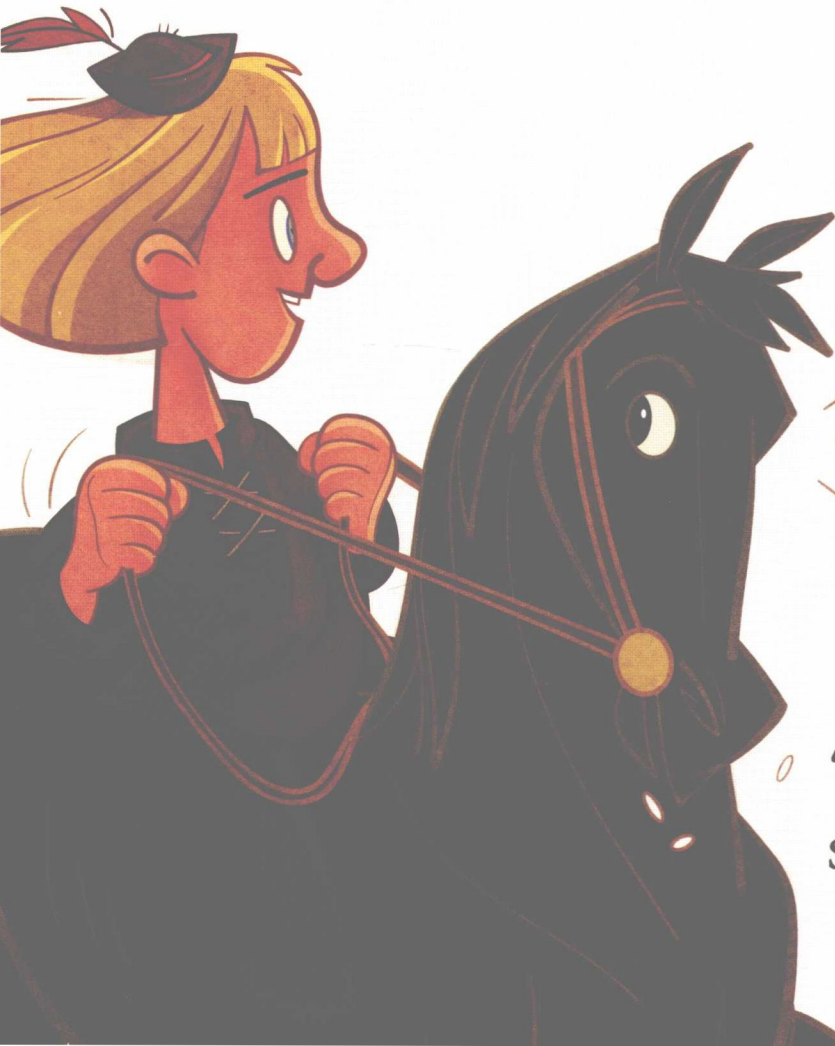
☞ It was hot on the road and Hans had a big bag of silver.

“You can have him for the bag of silver,” said the man.



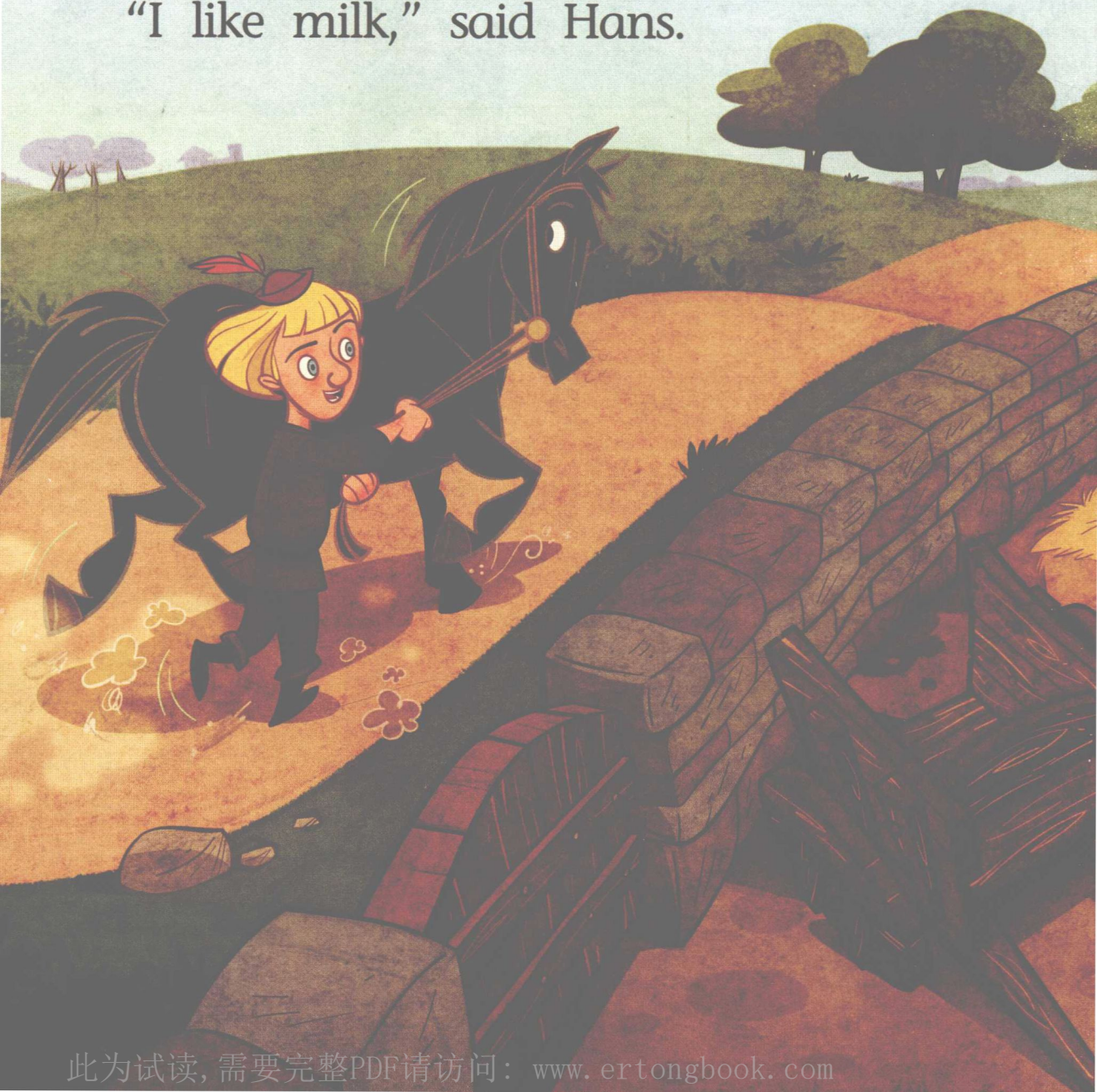
“What luck!”

"What luck!" said Hans. "I like eggs."

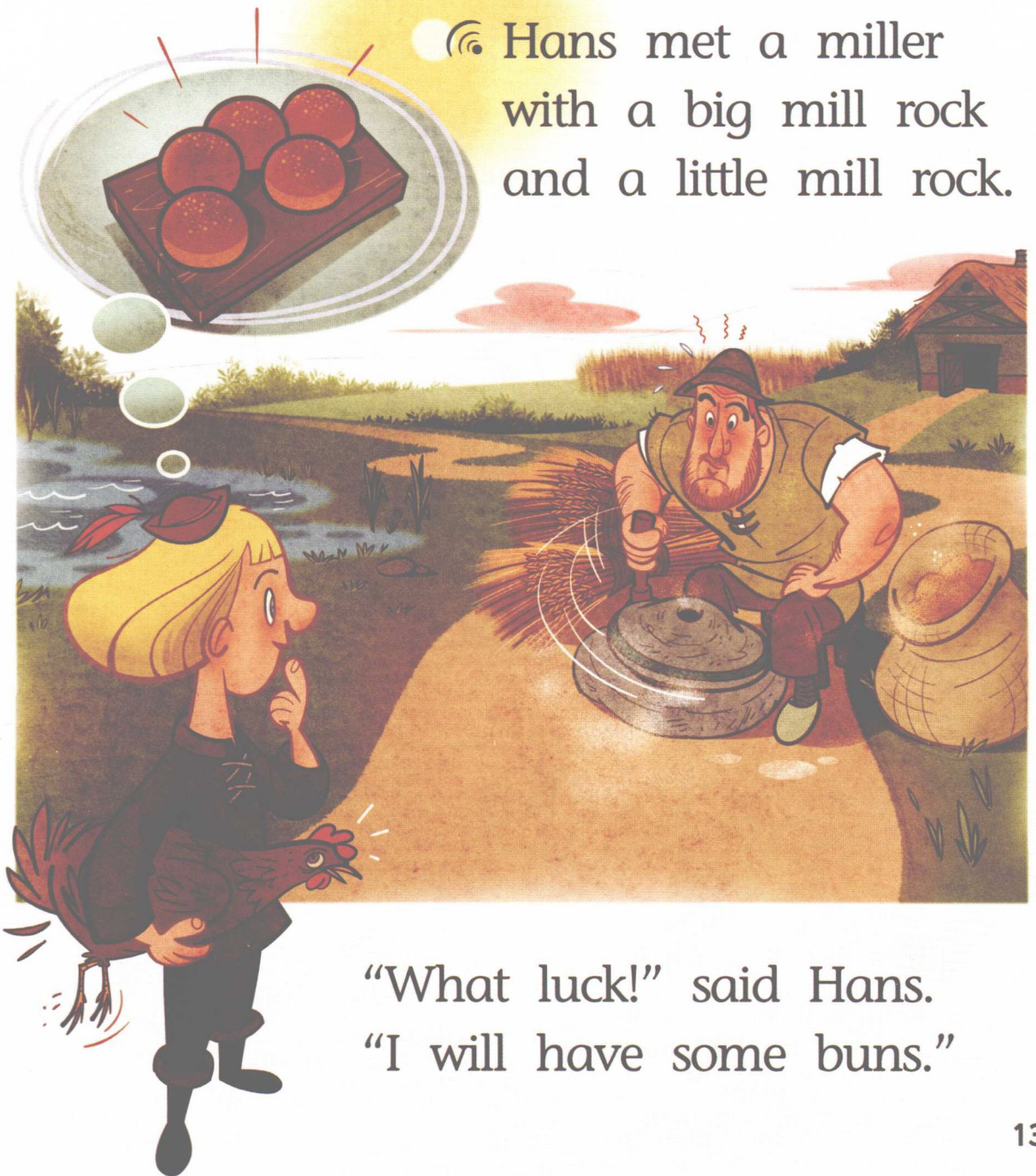




☞ But Hans got a peck.
