

WHY THIS BOOK WAS WRITTEN

With the College Board's announcement that an essay would be added to the new SAT, even American students are feeling pressured to improve their writing skills. Without a doubt, Korean students and their parents are getting stressed about this issue as well. Writing in one's first language is hard enough; writing in a second language is even harder.



I remember an article I read about a Korean parent who discovered something disturbing at her child's elementary school. She witnessed her son sitting alone, coloring a piece of paper while the rest of the class was learning to write. The teacher had to separate him from the other students and let him do whatever he wanted so that he wouldn't become noisy and disturb other students. The reason he was so disruptive was that he hated writing, so instead of paying attention to what he wasn't good at, he chose to annoy other students during writing class.


