前言

《大学英语基础教程》系列教材是一套从零起点开始的英语基础教材,主要供全国各高校入学时未学过英语或英语基础薄弱的学生,特别是少数民族地区的学生使用,同时也适合各专科学校、各艺术类院校以及自学者使用,学完全套教程后相当于大学英语二级水平。本系列教材由精读、听说、语法、阅读四种教程组成,各教程相互呼应,构成有机整体。

《大学英语基础教程》自出版以来已在全国 20 多所大专院校中使用,我们对该套教材的科学性、实用性等做了大量的跟踪调查。为了满足读者的需求,使该套教材完整、配套,根据反馈的意见,以教育部最新颁布的《大学英语课程教学要求(试行)》为指导思想,我们又编写了此系列的配套教材《大学英语基础听说教程》、《大学英语基础语法教程》和《大学英语基础阅读教程》。

阅读是学习外语的主要途径之一。学习者只有通过阅读进行大量的语言输入,才能有效提高自己综合运用英语的能力。为了切实有效地帮助学生完成一定的语言输入量,扩大自己的知识面和自如运用所学知识,我们编写了《大学英语基础阅读教程》。本教程既可以作为配套教材使用,也可以供所有初级、中级学习者单独使用。

本教程具有以下特点:

- 1. 选材新颖、题材广泛。本书所选文章涵盖科技、人文、史地、风俗、文化等各方面的 内容,题材多样,读者可以领略到不同的风格。
- 2. 练习形式多样。本书的练习不只局限于选择题。非选择题型有判断正误、填空、回答问题、完成句子等多种形式。不同类型的练习不但可以帮助学生提高对各种题材文章的理解能力,全面地增长知识,而且可以有针对性地对阅读能力相对较弱的某一类题材的文章进行专门的阅读和训练,从而提高学生对某一知识领域材料的阅读理解能力。
- 3. 难易兼顾。所选文章由浅人深、由易到难、循序渐进。全书分为两大部分: 1) 1—120篇为基础篇,该部分文章的生词量一般控制在3%—5%以内。学生可在理解的基础上,加快阅读速度, 2) 121—150篇为提高篇,该部分文章难度加大,词汇量也随之加大。学生在提高阅读速度和阅读能力的同时,进一步增加词汇量,提高对词汇的理解能力。

在本书的编写过程中,我们得到了外语教学与研究出版社及其社长李朋义先生、新疆大学校领导、教务处以及新疆大学外国语学院的大力支持。有了他们的支持和帮助,本书才得以顺利出版。在此,谨向在编写过程中给予我们支持、帮助和关怀的各级领导、同仁和朋友们表示衷心的感谢!

最后,恳请广大读者及同行在使用过程中多提宝贵意见。
