前 言

本教材主要供中学毕业班学生使用，也可供教师在各年级教学中编选补充练习时参考。

本书将一些中学英语的基本语言点列为练习项目 (item)，每一项目约有 3—4 个练习 (exercise)，共有 75 个项目，249 个练习。这些项目和练习可按顺序做，也可根据学生实际，选用其中一部分。一般讲，这些习题都要求学生先口头练习，再笔头巩固。

本书的特点是语法讲解从简，语法术语少用，着重于让学生通过口笔头练习来掌握基本语言点。对一些最基本的语法结构形式和用法需要讲解时，教师可适当进行补充(例如某种时态的形式和基本用法等)。本书在注解 (note) 中仅就容易混淆的概念和一些习惯用法加以说明。

书后附有不规则动词表、词汇表、惯用词组 (expressions)、英汉对照的练习说明 (exercise directions) 以及部分练习 (填充和译

成英语)的答案。其答案主要是针对该项目要求而作的,并不是唯一的答案。

本教材由于编写时间仓促,编者水平有限,一定存在不少缺点和错误,欢迎提出批评和建议。
