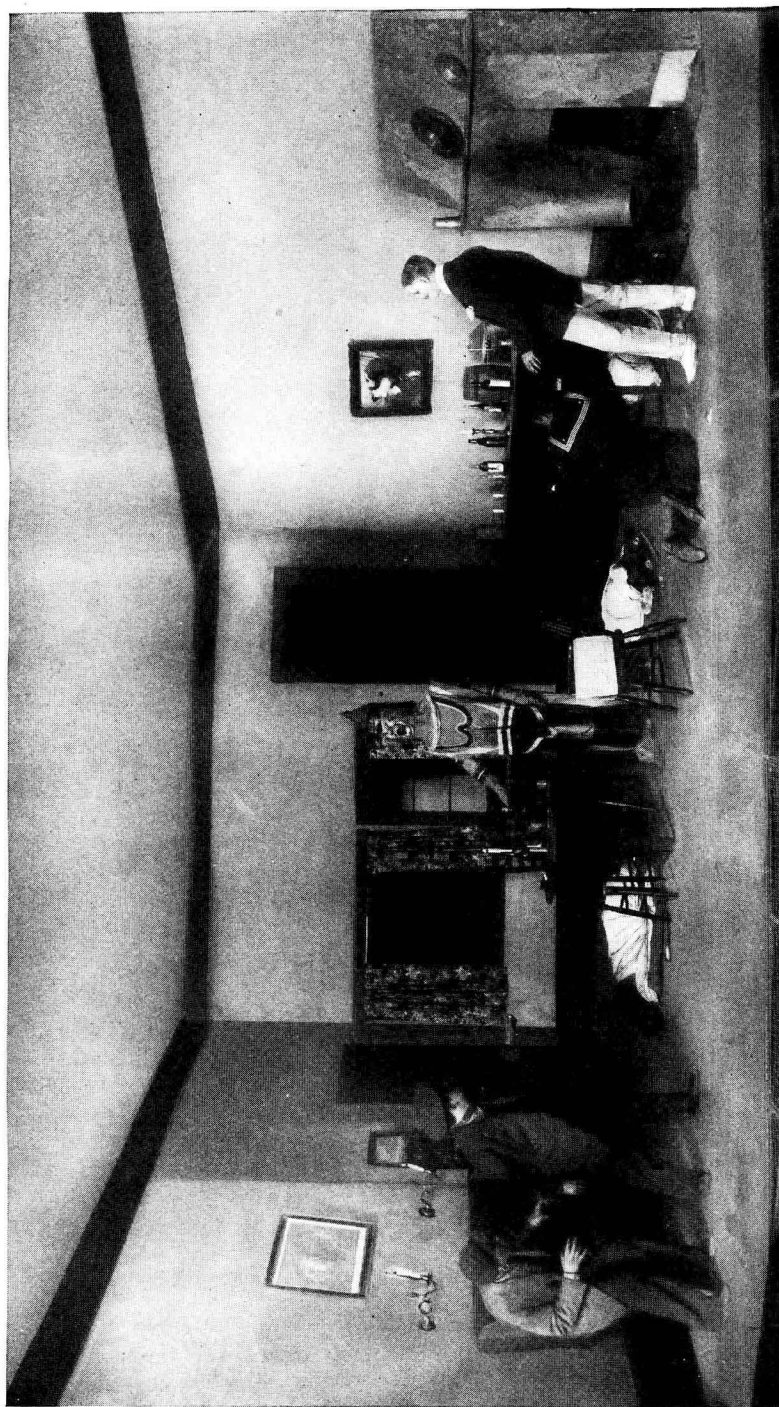

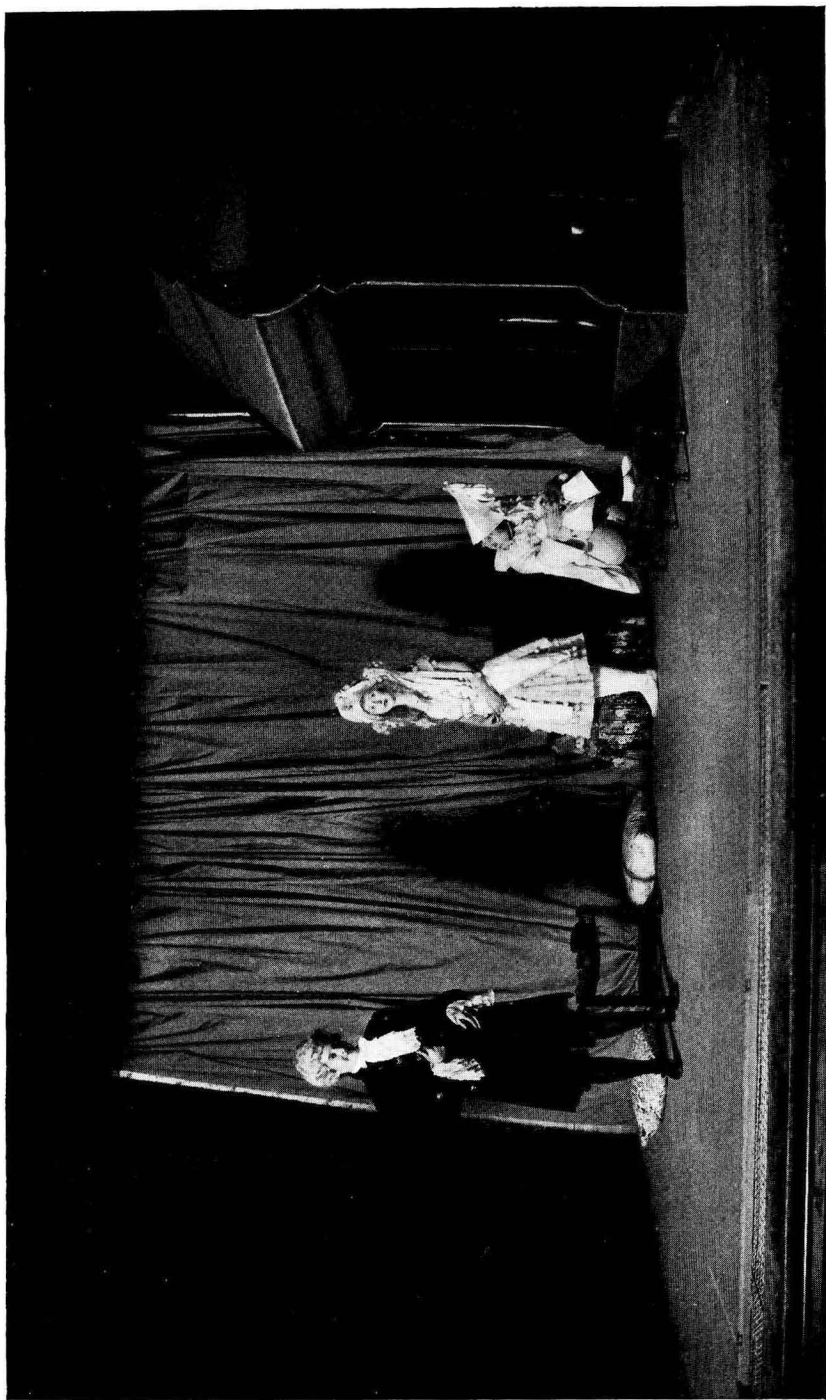

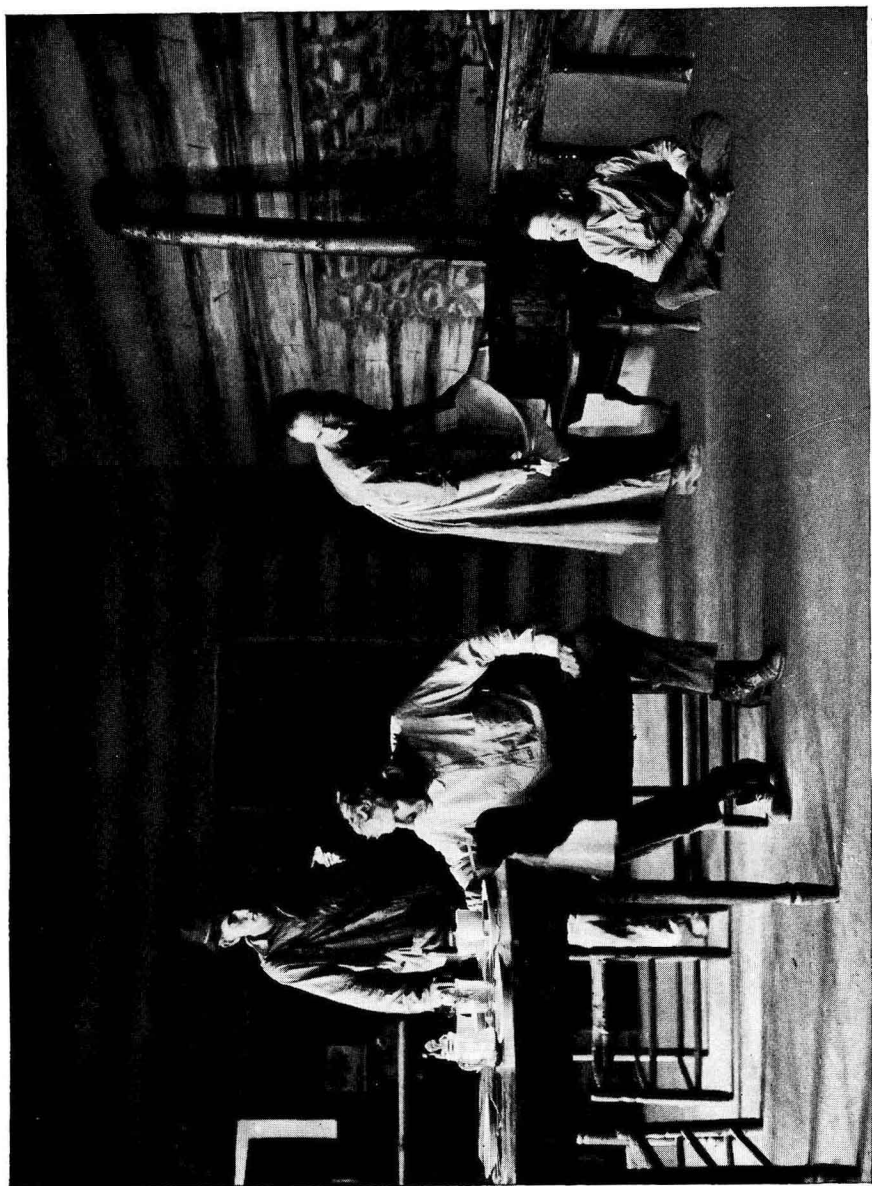
Dunsany's *A Night at an Inn* as given at the Neighborhood Playhouse, New York

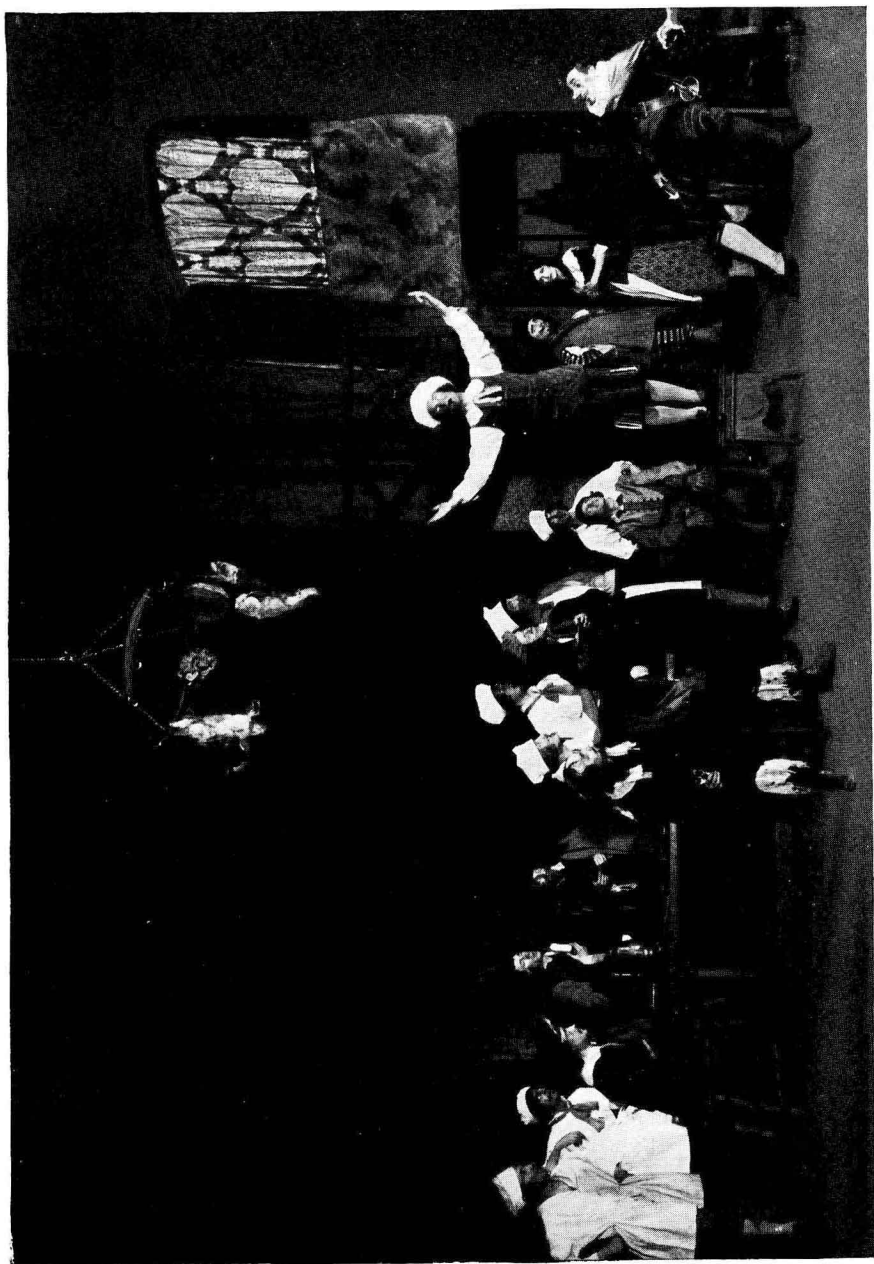

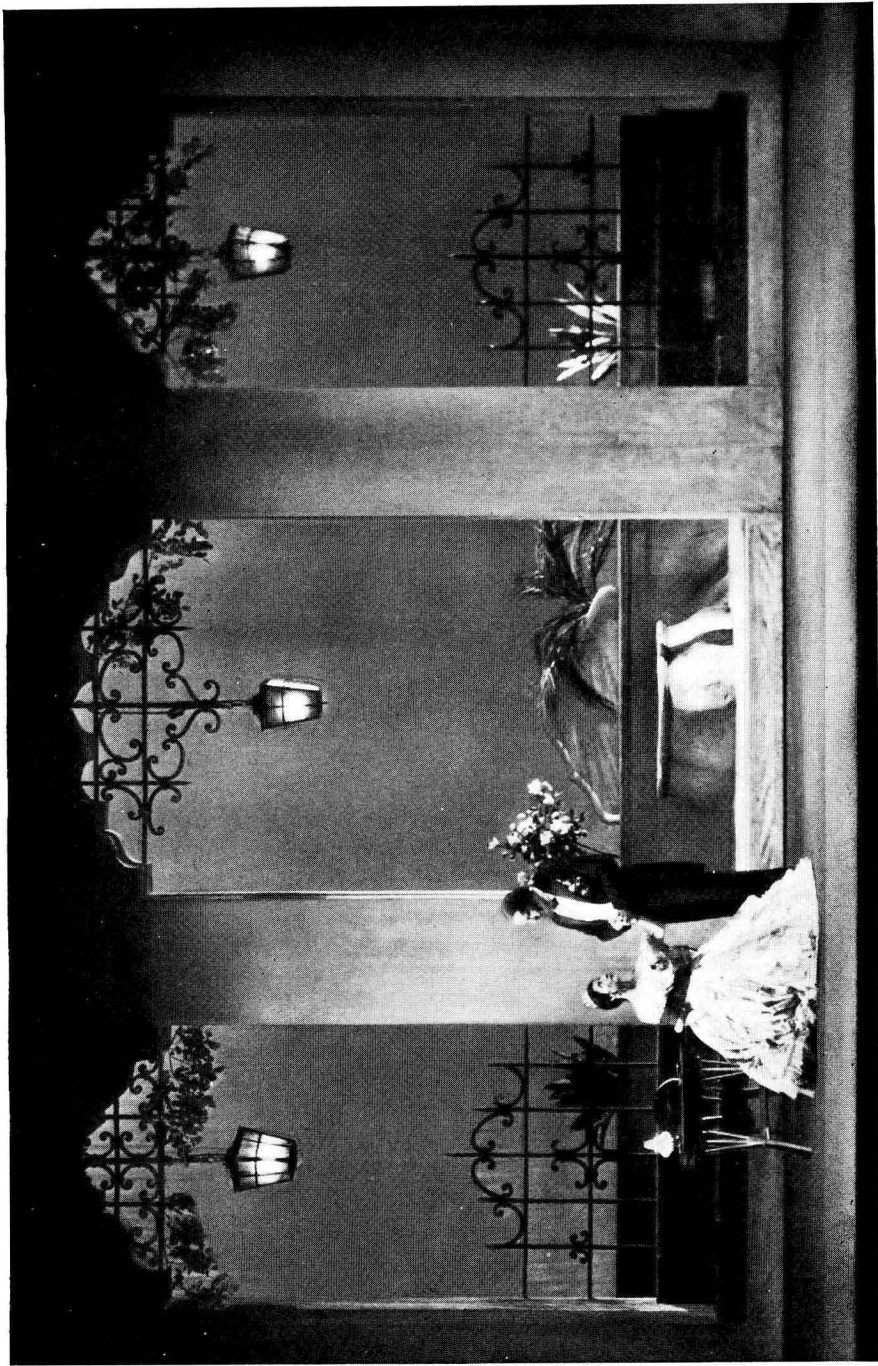

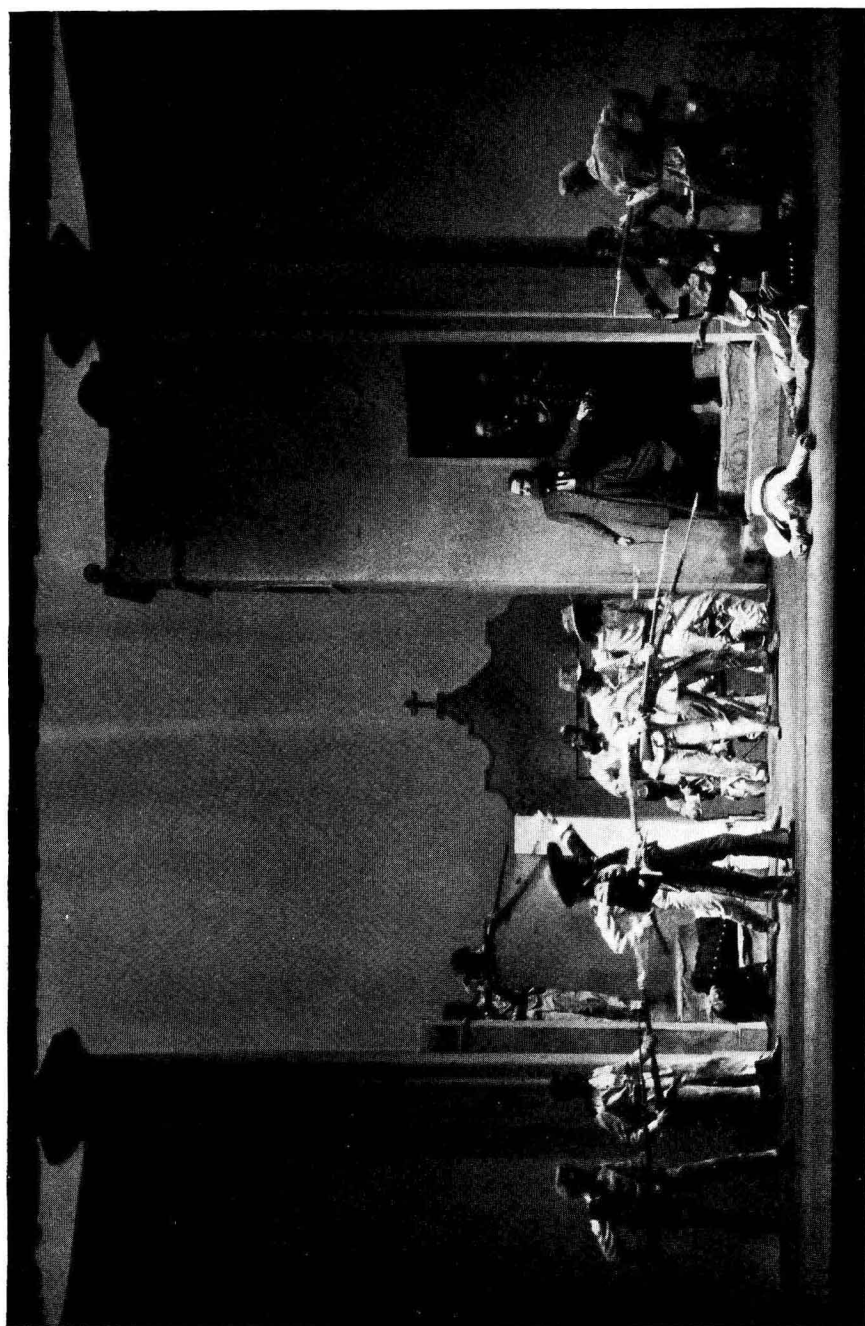
