

I wish you all happy and healthy during your stay in Shanghai and bring back beautiful memories of our city.



## 3. Competition Site and Equipment

#### 3.1. Competition Site

The Shanghai Natatorium with a seating capacity of 4500 including

VIP area and area for media, is located in Xuhui District, Shanghai, which is 3 km away from the athletes Hotel.

The swimming pool is 50m x 21m, and 2.2m—3.1m in depth.

The diving pool is 25m x 21m, and 4.5m—5.5m in depth. It is equipped with 10m, 7.5m, 5m, and 3m platforms and 1m and 3m springboards.

#### 3.2. Equipment

The lane markers in the swimming pool are the products of Dong Fang Sports Equipment Factory of Guangzhou, China. The metal springboards for diving are U.S. made, C type.

The Swiss made OMEGA Timing and Scoring System will be used in the competition of swimming and diving.

#### 3.3. Training Site

Shanghai Natatorium Training Pool with size of 51m×8m shall be divided into two 25m pools with 1.45m—1.70m in depth to be used for training.

### 4. Competition Information

#### 4.1. Accreditation Cards

Accreditation cards shall be issued to all the participating athletes and officials upon their arrival. The AD cards are for the access to competition arena, training site, designated hotel and also for the use of facilities. The athletes and officials are requested to carry their AD cards at all times during the Games to be shown for checking at entrances. Any loss of AD cards must be reported to the Security Department

immediately.

#### 4.2. Femininity Control

Femininity control tests will be conducted in accordance with FINA Regulations. Athletes holding valid femininity certificates issued by the IOC Medical Committee or FINA or by the Organizing Committee of a continental games may be exempted from the test.

#### 4.3. Technical Meetings

The technical meeting for swimming and diving will be held two days before the competition of swimming and diving. A written information will be given to all the participating teams upon their arrival.

- 4.4. Drawing of Lots for Diving Competition and Dives Selected Form
- 4.4.1. The starting order shall be decided by drawing of lots at the technical meeting before the competition.
- 4.4.2. The signed dives selected form must be submitted to the Competition Office of the Swimming Commission 24 hours prior to the competition of the event.

#### 4.5. Warm-up

#### 4.5.1. Swimming

The Swimming Pool is available for swimmers to warm-up one hour and a half before each session of the competition.

The pool will be cleared 15 minutes before the beginning of the competition. During the competition, the swimmers may have training in the training pool.

#### 4.5.2. Diving

The Diving Pool is available for divers to warm-up one hour and a . 10.

half before each session of the competition.

The pool will be cleared 15 minutes before the beginning of each event.

#### 4.6. Check-in

The swimmers and divers are requested to report to the check-in desk with their AD cards 15 minutes before the start of each scheduled event. The swimming suit of swimmers and divers must be in conformity with the FINA Regulations. Any delayed check-in made less than 5 minutes before each event would result in disqualification from the competition.

The swimmers and divers are to be ushered to the competition area.

#### 4.7. Result Bulletin Service

A mail box shall be designated to each team and technical officials in a special place in Qianhe Hotel where the results bulletins can be collected.

#### 4.8. Victory Ceremony

- 4.8.1. The victory ceremony will be held 3—5 minutes after the final of each event at designated place in the competition area.
- 4.8.2. The winners shall wear their team uniforms or traditional costumes and assemble quickly for the ceremony.
- 4.8.3. The Chinese and English languages will be used at the victory ceremonies.
  - 4.8.4. The victory ceremony will be proceeded as follows:
  - 4.8.4.1. Playing of fanfare music
  - 4.8.4.2. Announcing the opening of the victory ceremony
  - 4.8.4.3. Winners parade to the awarding area

- 4.8.4.4. Announcement of the final result
- 4.8.4.5. Medals and flowers presentation
- 4.8.4.6. Raising the flags and playing the anthem
- 4.8.4.7. Exit of the medalists
- 4.9. Interview and Press Conference
- 4.9.1 Special seats are reserved for press in the competition venue. Only those who possess the special passes issued by the Organizing Committee may have access to the competition area.
- 4.9.2. Following the victory ceremony, a press conference for the medalists will be held in ten minutes in the interview room in the Swimming Natatorium. The medalists, their coaches and officials will be interviewed by the press.

#### 4.10. Doping Control

Doping control tests will be conducted during the Shanghai East Asian Games for swimming and diving competitors in accordance with the Regulations of the Medical Commission of Olympic Council of Asia and the Regulations of FINA. The method and the number of competitors to undergo the test will be agreed upon by SEAGOC and the Coordination Committee of the East Asian NOCs.

#### 4.11. Protests

Protests will be handled in accordance with the Regulations laid down in the current FINA Handbook.
