孩子們熱愛書籍,書籍給他們帶來了智慧和力量。請看第六十五頁,應他們一雙雙天真明亮、渴求知識的眼睛,在書的海洋中探索、蕩漾,那聚精會神閱讀書籍的神態,多麽可愛,氫叫人想上前觀觀他的額頭。

This color-picture album "Women • China • Life", published by WOMEN OF CHINA is composed of hundred and ninety photos chosen from some fifty thousand shots taken by WOMEN OF CHINA photograph in the last seven years, with captions in Chinese and English. I hope this volume will be a vehicle for culture exchange around the globe and understanding among the women of China and those of other countries.

I've gone over the album with great interest. It is lively and imaginative, and it reflects the diversity of or temporary women of all nationalities in China. These vivid pictures present readers with Chinese women's de cation to their careers, their love for their motherland, their selfless contribution to society, and their purs of happiness.

On page 23, smiling mothers celebrate National Day with their babies. A little girl holding flowers rides her father's shoulders. She may not understand what she sees, but she is rapt.

At Tiananmen Square, the photographer has captured a touching scene — a grandson bends towards I grandmother's wheelchair to hear what she says to him as he pushes her through the square, while his wife loo on lovingly. What a harmonious scene! It epitomizes the contentment of thousands upon thousands of happfamilies in China. This picture is on page 29.

Nineteen eighty-six is the Year of International Peace. A photo on page 97 shows children of different colors painting with brushes their wishes for peace. They are the hope of humankind, the symbol of peace and friendship. Just looking at this picture lifts the spirit and gives one hope.

Books bring children wisdom and strength. Look at page 65. The children's innocent eyes show their yearning for knowledge. I think if they were here before me, I would take them in my arms and kiss them.

The album "Women • China • Life" reproduces pictures of Chinese women as they really are, in cities as well as in the countryside. Whether they are technicians, scholars or ordinary workers; girls in the full flower of life or white-haired people; women of minority nationalities in border areas, or Han women in inland China, all are working hard and contributing their wisdom and talents to the modernization of our motherland.


Chinese women are marching into a new historical era; anyone who sees this album, I believe, will come to the same conclusion.







