 6. Yes, but that was three weeks ago.

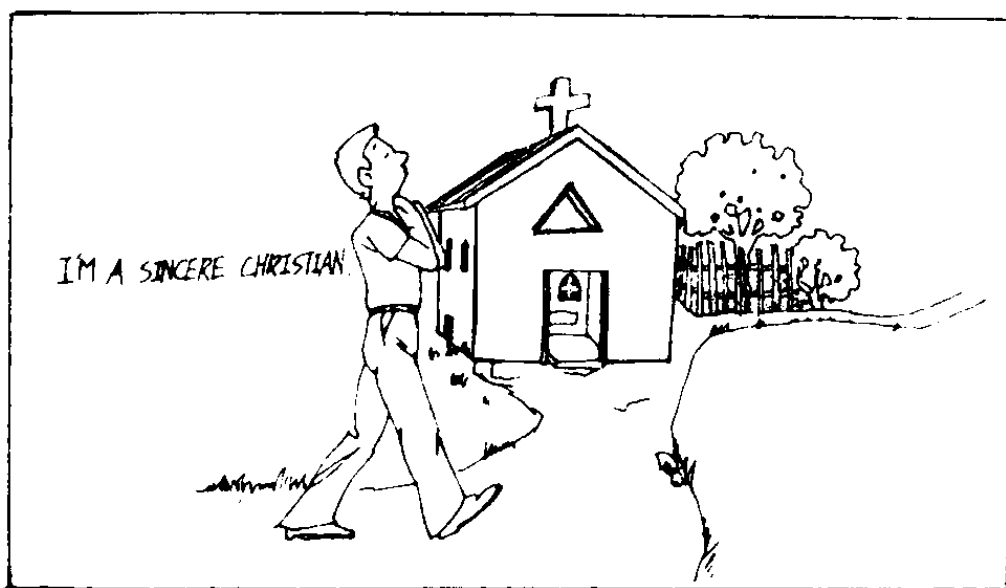
DRILL

Jane: I don't want to argue with you. I know I'm bound to lose if I argue with fanatics. You can't reason with them.

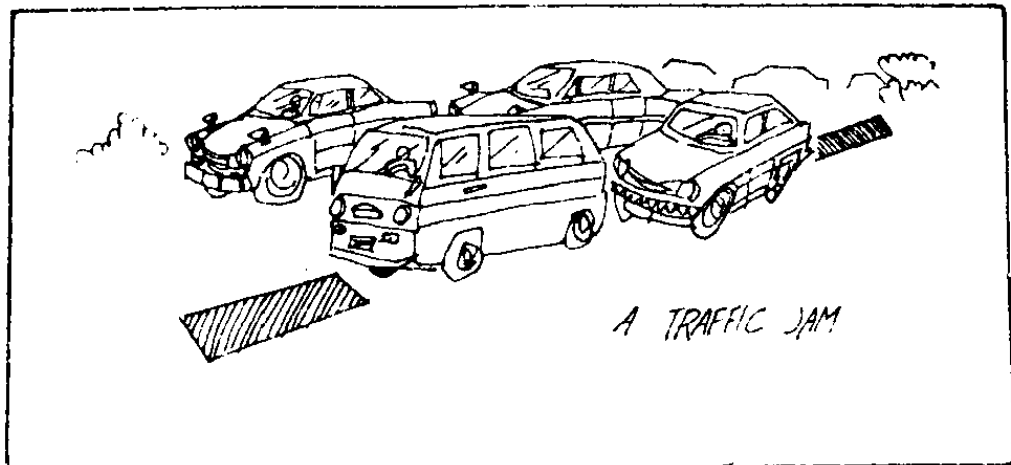
Billy: Then let's drop the topic.
