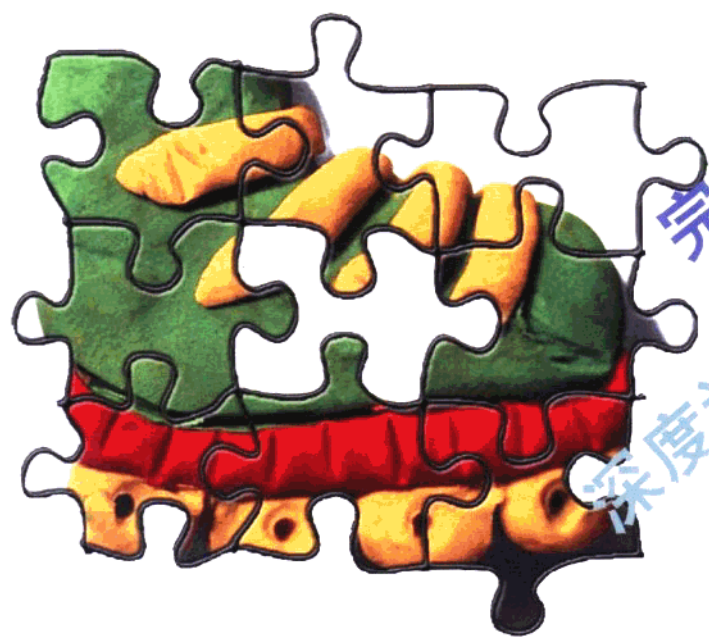
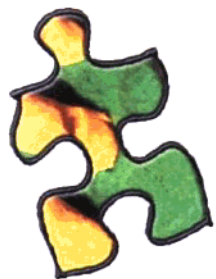

前 言

本丛书是以全日制高中英语新教材内容为依据编写而成的复习指导丛书。本丛书共分五本,听力理解、语法综合、完形填空、阅读理解、翻译与写作。每本单册都尽可能配有难点分析与讲解,尤其是中学生中存在比较多的疑问集中在语法与完形中,以下为各分册的简介:

听力理解:从2001年起,高考中进行听力测试。开展英语学科素质教育,提高英语的综合能力,培养学生的创新思想,听力都起着十分重要的作用。为了使学生了解、熟悉高考英语听力的具体要求和形式,加强对英语听力训练,本书以模拟高考听力的形式和需求,编写出25套仿真试题,附有录音文字及参考答案,并配有音带8盒,力图给学生以现场感与实践感。

语法选择:本书共有16套试题组成,每套精心筛选100题,试题分层出现,由浅入深,循序渐进,以达最佳训练效果,并且对某些学生学习中易混淆,难掌握的语言重点和难点进行了解释,而且有的在光盘中归纳总结,使读者看后能触类旁通,举一反三。

完形填空:包括100篇,选项个数从10个到25个,每篇后都配有难点分析、讲解等。并抓知识点,进行精辟分析,巧解其中的重点和难点,讲清解题思路和方法,挖掘知识内在联系,点拨关键问题。整本书的内容紧扣教学大纲和教材,又有适当的加深拓宽,以培养学生解题的基本功和综合能力。建议学生先做完题,然后对答案,如果不对的再看讲解,这样效果会更好。

阅读理解:这一题是高考试题中阅读量最大,词汇最多,分值最高,考试分配时间最长的部分。该书选文特点:题材多样,

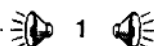
内容丰富,包括科普常识、政治、经济、文史地理、材料摘录、社会热点、新闻报道等,充分体现现代英语教育的目的,反映素质教育的客观要求。

翻译和书面表达:翻译是高考卷中有特色的一项试题,学生平时翻译中出现的情况加以归纳总结,精选300句,其中包括重要的句型、单词、片语、惯用语、文法等,最重要的是精选练习学生易错的单词、习语及重要难点句型。写作表达是历年教学资料和学生高考复习的重点。本习题经多次精选,全部经过教学实践的检验,体裁多样,内容丰富,由浅入深,充分考虑了不同层次学生的需要。
