言

本丛书是以全日制高中英语新教材内容为依据编写而成的 复习指导丛书。本丛书共分五本,听力理解、语法综合、完形填 空、阅读理解、翻译与写作。每本单册都尽可能配有难点分析与 讲解,尤其是中学生中存在比较多的疑问集中在语法与完形中, 以下为各分册的简介:

听力理解:从2001年起,高考中进行听力测试。开展英语 学科素质教育,提高英语的综合能力,培养学生的创新思想,听 力都起着十分重要的作用。为了使学生了解、熟悉高考英语听 力的具体要求和形式,加强对英语听力训练,本书以模拟高考听 力的形式和需求,编写出25套仿真试题,附有录音文字及参考 答案,并配有音带8盒,力图给学生以现场感与实践感。

语法选择:本书共有16套试题组成,每套精心筛选100题, 试题分层出现,由浅入深,循序渐进,以达最佳训练效果,并且对 某些学生学习中易混淆,难掌握的语言重点和难点进行了解释, 而且有的在光盘中归纳总结,使读者看后能触类旁通,举一反 三。

完形填空:包括 100 篇,选项个数从 10 个到 25 个,每篇后都配有难点分析、讲解等。并抓知识点,进行精辟分析,巧解其中的重点和难点,讲清解题思路和方法,挖掘知识内在联系,点拨关键问题。整本书的内容紧扣教学大纲和教材,又有适当的加深拓宽,以培养学生解题的基本功和综合能力。建议学生先做完题,然后对答案,如果不对的再看讲解,这样效果会更好。

阅读理解:这一题是高考试题中阅读量最大,词汇最多,分值最高,考试分配时间最长的部分。该书选文特点:题材多样,

内容丰富,包括科普常识、政治、经济、文史地理、材料摘录、社会 热点、新闻报道等,充分体现现代英语教育的目的,反映素质教 育的客观要求。

翻译和书面表达:翻译是高考卷中有特色的一项试题,学生平时翻译中出现的情况加以归纳总结,精选 300 句,其中包括重要的句型、单词、片语、惯用语、文法等,最重要的是精选练习学生易错的单词、习语及重要难点句型。写作表达是历年教学资料和学生高考复习的重点。本习题经多次精选,全部经过教学实践的检验,体裁多样,内容丰富,由浅入深,充分考虑了不同层次学生的需要。

^前 本书的疏漏、错误之处亦在所难免,希望广大读者不吝赐 章 教,以便进一步修订。
