GDP growth rate of Asian economies³









GDP spending on education and libraries9




Uses of library funds worldwide




Total funding 2000– 2002 (\$, millions)




Largest private library funding foundations




U.S. public libraries—materials budget response to budget cuts








DRM Functional Architecture diagram²⁴





Learning object life cycle diagram⁹ 彩图 25






Scholarly information flow-Then



Content management services: repository architectures, preservation, knowledge organization, retrieval ... e.g., OAIS, DSpace, Fedora, LCSH, Dewey ...

Packaging: OAIS SIP/AIP/DIP, METS, RSS, SCORM, IMS-CPS

Information resources:

text, static images, moving images, audio, multimedia ... HTML, PDF, JPEG, GIF, MPG ...

Metadata:

discovery, technical, administrative, structural DCMI, MARC, MODS, MIX, EAD, LOM ...

Presentation

Rendering: browser, database interfaces, media players ...

Application services

Generic Web services: UDDI, WSDL, SOAP, XSLT ...

Discovery services: Xquery, SRW/SRU, Z39.50 ...

Aggregation services: OAI, RSS, Web services, Semantic







Top ten spoken languages 8




Online language populations 8


