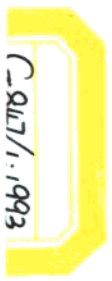

3.Competition Site and Equipment

The badminton competition will be held at the Huangpu Gymnasium which is located in the downtown area of Shanghai. It is 2km from the athletes' residence and takes about 20 minutes to reach by bus. It has a seating capacity of 3,400 with areas for VIPs and press. Its floor size is 36 × 21m in dimensions with four courts set up for the competition.

The official shuttlecock will be "Aeroplane 101" made in China, the official court will be "YY Yonex" produced in Japan, and the official net and post will be "Shengli" made in China. All equipments are in conformity with the IBF Rules.

4.Training Site and Equipment

Seven courts will be available for practice at the Shanghai Badminton Training Center. It is 3.5km from the players' residence and takes about 15 minutes to reach by bus.

The organising Committee will provide three "Aeroplane 101" shuttlecocks free to each player for practice. More shuttlecocks can be purchased from the Badminton Commission.

5.Lounge for Athletes

Lounges for players, men's and women's changing rooms and shower rooms are available at the Huangpu Gymnasium. Men's and women's changing rooms are available at the Shanghai Badminton Training

Center.

6.Lounge for VIPs

There will be a VIP room at the Huangpu Gymnasium for VIPs and officials.

7.Map of Huangpu Gymnasium

7.1. Location map of the competition courts in Huangpu Gymnasium (see figure 1).

8.Accreditation Cards

All registered players and officials shall be issued Accreditation Cards upon their arrival. AD cards shall be used as indication of identification. The card holder may have access to the gymnasium, training hall, and the designated hotel and to use the facilities. Loss of AD card should be immediately reported to the Security Department.

9.Pre-match Registration and March-in

Competitors' registration desk is in the west hall near the Gymnasium entrance. Each player should register 30 minutes prior to his/her match at the registration desk according to the competition schedule

and have his/her competition suit checked. Late registration for more than 20 minutes will be regarded as automatic forfeiture. When the court number of the match is announced, the competitor should immediately report to the Umpire at the entrance of the court and follow the Umpire to march into the court. Late reporting for more than 10 minutes will be considered as automatic forfeiture. Only players participating in the spot match may enter the court area while others should take the assigned seats on the terrace.

A march-in ceremony will be held before each final. Competitors to be present at the ceremony shall assemble at the entrance 20 minutes before the match starts and be led into the court by the Umpire.

10. Technical Meeting

A team managers' meeting will be held two days before the competition. The exact date, time and place will be duly informed.

11. Protests and Appeals

Appeals must be lodged according to the IBF Regulations and Rules.

12. Team Composition for Team Event

Each team should submit three copies of its team composition for its coming match in block letters with the signature of the team captain to the referee at the Competition Division in the YMCA Hotel. The composition must be submitted one session before the team's match

according to the competition schedule. For matches start at 09:00, team compositions should be submitted at 20:00 hours the day before, and at 14:00 for matches at 19:30. Late submission of the composition for more than 30 minutes will be considered as automatic forfeiture.

13. Victory Ceremony

The players/teams winning the first three places of each event are requested to be present at the victory ceremony which will be held immediately after the final. The winners shall wear their team uniforms or traditional costumes and assemble at the competitors' registration desk to be ushered into the presentation area.

The victory ceremony will be held according to the prize-giving programme drawn up by the Organising Committee.

The ceremony will proceed as follows:

- (A) Playing of ceremonial music
- (B) Announcement of the start of the ceremony
- (C) Winners march-in
- (D) Announcement of results
- (E) Presentation of medals and flowers
- (F) Flag-raising and anthem-playing
- (G) Medalists march-off

14.Doping Control

Doping control tests will be conducted during the 1st East Asian Games badminton competition in accordance with the Rules of the OCA Sports Medical Commission and the IBF. The method of the test and the number of athletes undergo the tests will be agreed upon by the Organising Committee and the Coordination Committee of East Asia NOCs.

15.Femininity Control

In accordance with relevant regulations of the IBF, the Medical Department will jointly conduct femininity control test with the professional institution using internationally recognized technique.

Players holding feminity certificates issued by the IOC Medical Commission or international sports federations, or the Organising Committee of any continental sports games (or its Medical Committee) may be exempted from the test.

16.Press

Photographers and TV cameramen holding special passes issued by the Organizing Committee may have access to the competition area 2 meters from the court. Other journalists and reporters may have seats in the reserved area. Flashlights will be prohibited during the competition.

There will be a press conference room on the second floor of the east

hall of Huangpu Gymnasium. Press conferences will be held after each of the individual matches or ten minutes after the victory ceremony of each final. A bulletin box will be available for the journalists to collect results.

17. Medical Services

A clinic will be set up for players in the Hotel offering 24-hour medical service. First-aid stations will operate in the Gymnasium and at the Training Center for medical care and emergency service.

18. Transportation

To ensure that team will reach the venue on schedule for training, competitions and attending as spectators, shuttle buses will be arranged. For detailed information, please read the Transportation Information.

Vehicles will be available for hire. Details may also be found in the Transportation Information.

Transportation for delegation officials, VIPs, technical delegates, technical officials and journalists will be provided, please refer to the Reception Information for details.

19. Accommodations

Badminton teams participating in the First East Asian Games will be accommodated in the YMCA Hotel.

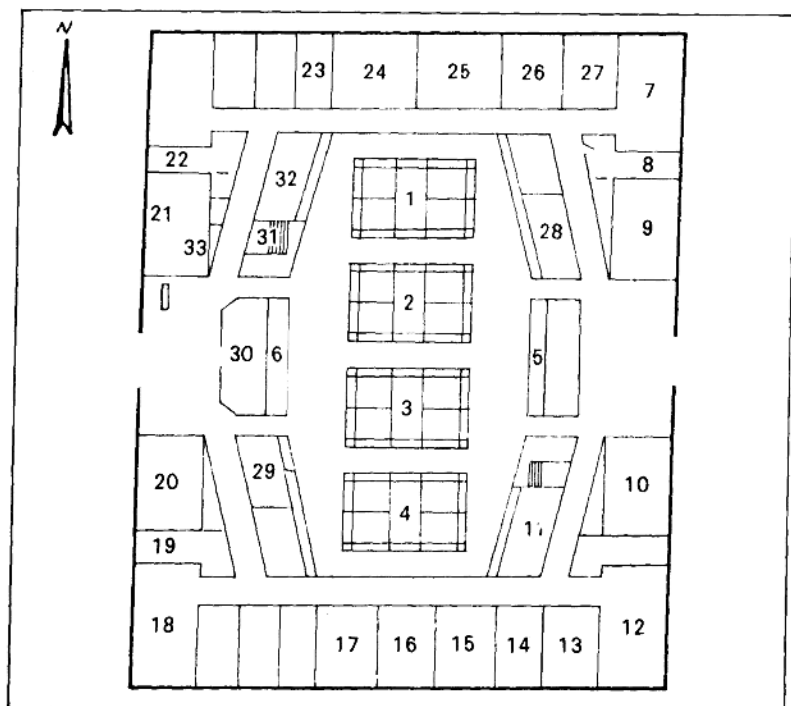
Meals will be served in self-service system. AD cards are requested to be shown at the entrance of the restaurant.

Soft drinks will be available free of charge at the competition and training sites.

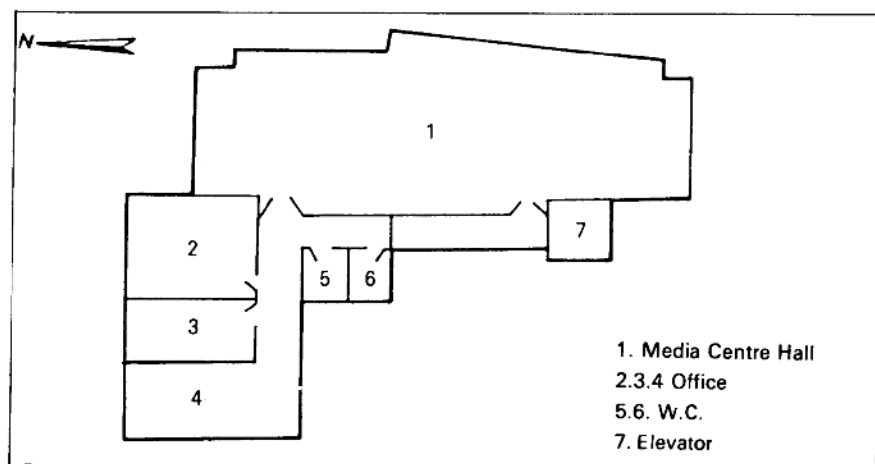
Plane Figure of the Competition Rooms
