本书共计八集,系从国外引进之最新听力测试资料,专供托夫考生提高听力之用。本听力资料分三部份,其中第三部份,即Part C篇幅较长,涉及照材较广,故由我校委请张联璋同志(江西师大副教授兼《英语辅导》主编)予以译出,以供参考。

如何准备托夫听力测验

托夫瀏验是由美国教育测验社(Educational Testing Service 简称 ETS)主办。测验的主要目的为鉴定非英语系国家学生赴美攻读具有之英语能力。

自 1964 年正式举办托夫测验以来,一直发展到今天,托夫测验的成绩不仅是全美国各大学和研究所入学许可与奖学金审核委员会评定申请者英文能力之依据。同时,此一考试成绩被视为美国国务院所属各国领事馆对申请美国学生签证的唯一合法考试。

托夫剛验计分三大单元,每一单元测验一项重要的语文技巧,所有题目皆使用选择法(Multiple Choices).

- 一、听力测验(Listening Comprehension),分为三大部份,包括简单听力二十题,会话听力十五题,演讲听力(包括会话、电合之报告(Bulletin)及一般通告(Announcement)等共十五题,其目的在测验学生口述英语之理解能力,听力测验之时间约为三十分钟。
- 二、英语结构及写作表达测验(Structure and Written Expression),此测验分为二部份,Part A 为十五题,主要目的在测验学生对美语惯用法之了解程度。Part B 为二十五题,其主要目的为测验学生文法及修辞改错之能力。此一部份之测验时间为二十五分钟。
- 三、阅读及词汇测验(Reading Comprehension and Vocabulary): 此测验亦分为两部份, Part A 为词汇, 共三十颗, 其主

要目的在测验学生对现代美国成语及词汇辩义之了解。Part B 为 阅读测验,亦为三十题。计有单句、广告及段落之文字多篇,其主要 为测验学生之英文阅读理解及演译推理之能力。此部份之考试时间共 为四十五分钟。

1. 如何考好托夫听力测验部份

听力测验分 A、B、C 三个部份, 共五十题, 考试时间约三十为分钟。 A 部份共有二十题, 录音带会放出一个叙述句, 考生要从试卷上所列的四个答案中, 找出一个与所听到的叙述句相同意思的答案来。这一部份的题目都是比较短的, 最长不超过两句话, 并且皆属于一般日常口头用语, 没有麻烦的文法问题牵涉在内, 也绝不会有很长的, 或陌生的字出现。

例如:

- (A) John should go to the movies.
- (B) John should have studied the movie.
- (C) John went to study.
 - (D) John didn't study.

假者你所听到的叙述句是:

Instead of studying John went to the movies. 正确的答案应该是(D)。

例如:

- (A) It is big.
- (B) It is cold.
- (C). It is stuffy.

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(D) It is small.

假如你所听到叙述句是:

This room is lack of air.

正确的答案应该是(C),

从上面的例句中,我们就可以看出,叙述句的答案是 相 同 性 质 的,四个答案之中,必定有相反意义的但是都是简明扼要,一目了然 的,绝不会有冗长的答案。 A部份的题目与题目之间,间隔有十秒钟 的时间,读答案的时间一定要快,如一经决定,应马上看下一题的四个答案,如此才有充裕的时间考完听力的 A部份,换句话说,学生的 眼睛应该走在耳朵的前面,一俟听到问题,马上可以挑出答案来。

万一有一题不会做,应立刻放弃或者任选一个答案再专心看下一 题的答案,听下一题的问题,否则你将会连续数题听不清楚,不智之 至,

B部份共十五题,每题也是四个答案,通常是一男一女对话,再由第三者针对以上的会话,提出一个问题,我们应考者就应该从这四个答案中,挑选一个最适当的答案来。

例如:

- (A) She was sitting too far back.
- (B) She didn't understard the subject.
- (C) She arrived after it had begun.
- (D) She couldn't get a seat.

假如我们听到像这样的一段会话和题目,

- (man's voice) So you were at the lecture last night, too.
- (woman's voice) Yes, but I hope you heard more of it than we could. I simply can't understand why they hold lectures in that big

hall.

(man's voice)

It certainly isn't the ideal place for lectures.

We've found it's best to go there early and take seats up front.

(3 rd voice)

Why did the woman find the lecture unsatisfactory?

从这段会话中,我们知道他们二人都参加了昨晚的演讲,但是那位女士认为礼堂太大,听不太清楚,那位男士也认为那地方也确实太大了点,所以最好的方法就是早去,早占前面的座位。第三者所问的问题是那位女士为什么对昨晚的演讲不满意,根据以上的会话,我们认为只有(A)最好,那我们就应该挑(A)。

B 部份虽然比较复杂点,而实际上要比A部份容易的多,因为你已先听到了会话的情况后,再听到问题,在时间上比较充份。但最重要的是第三者所问的问题,应考者们也应该特别注意所听问题的第一个字。

假如以上例题的会话部份不变,而问题稍有变动:

(3 rd voice) What did the woman complain about? 我们就应该把原来答案中的(A)换一下,换成:

(A) The hall is too big for lectures. 假如问题再变动一下。

(3 rd voice) What suggestion did the man give her? 那么正确的答案应该是:

(A) Be there early and take seats up front.

C部份有 15 题,其中包括数篇短的演讲或报告、二人之对话、 广播节目之道自或其他形式之讲述,题材都是留美学生在日常生活或 学校中经常听到的。每段后有四或五个问题,问题已经预先录造好在 录音带上,考卷本内只含四个答案,第一小段读完后马上问问题,问 隔也是只有八或几秒钟,所以应考者必须全神贯注方能如意作答。

Part A

Directions: For each problem in Part A, you will hear a short statement. The statements will be spoken just one time. They will not be written out for you, and you must listen carefully in order to understand what the speaker says.

When you hear a statement, read the four sentences in your test book and decide which one is closest in meaning to the statement you have heard. Then, on your answer sheet, find the number of the problem and mark your answer.
