The table presents the information about company profits before tax in late 1980s. The table is a two - dimension table which represented four different sectors of Industry in the horizontal direction: Manufacturing, Mining, Retail Trade and Other Industries.

From left to right, in the first section company profits before tax reached the peak which is \$ 8,617 million from 1986 to 1987. Then in Mining, the profits fell to the bottom which is \$ 3,540 million from 1988 to 1989, and again rose to the peak of \$ 4,992 million from 1989 to 1990. The third section is Retail Trade where profits rose to \$ 1,349 million from 1988 to 1989 after a slow but steady growth of company profits in two years from 1986 to 1988, and then fell a bit to \$ 1,373 million in the year that followed. In the last section, other industries, a steady growth in profits was seen in the first three years from \$ 1,232 million to \$ 1,696 million and then it fell quickly to \$ 397 million from 1989 to 1990.

From this table, we can predict that company profits of Australia in Manufacturing, and Other Industries will probably decrease in the 1990s though Mining and Retail Trade saw an increase in the 1989 - 1990 period.

HONESTY: THE BEST POLICY?

The line between hope and false hope is often blurry and easy to cross. It is very hard for doctors to balance keeping hope alive with keeping expectations realistic. Oftentimes the doctors see their job as providing encouragement to the patients and tend to hold back discouraging information. But I do not think this is a good practice.

By avoiding telling patients that there is little that can be done to treat their conditions, the doctor may start a series of futile tests and therapies, thus wasting money for the patient.

Being able to talk to the patient about their disease is probably the best way to navigate through all the ambiguities of honesty and truth – telling in the doctor – patient relationship. In any case, learning about the medical condition can help prepare the patient for major choices about treatment.

Even when a cure isn't possible, the alternative needn't be giving up hope altogether. Doctors and patients need to rethink what it is they're hoping for. For example, if the condition is terminal, the goal can be freedom from pain, living to an important holiday or anniversary, drawing support from loved ones, or dying with dignity. For chronic conditions that aren't life – threatening, the goal should be thoroughly managing the disease so the person can get as much out of life as possible. By building trust between doctors and patients, doctors can facilitate the communication with their patients and enable the patients to make informed decisions.

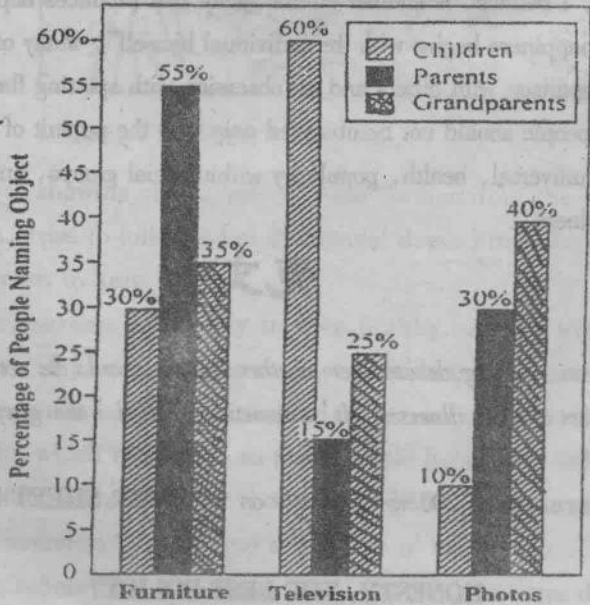

Most Valued Objects in the Home

"What objects in your home do you value the most?" If this question is posed to children, parents and grandparents, then the answer can be found in the graph. Let us consider it in detail.

Furniture is valued most by parents. Everybody will agree that children do not show much interest in furniture; they are occupied with playing. Grandparents are also less interested in furniture than parents are. The reason may be that older people show less affection for material things, and more affection for memories and other immaterial objects.

Television is favoured most by children. It is common knowledge that children love to watch television, especially programs with cartooned animals and creatures. Grandparents also like to watch television though not half as much as the children. A solid explanation seems that they have a lot of free time and do not know what to do with it. Parents hardly watch television. They have to work routinely, and they have to take care of the children and sometimes of the grandparents too.

Not surprisingly, photos are valued most by grandparents. As was said above, older people tend to value memories and other immaterial objects most. Photos are nothing more or less than memories. Parents also value photos, less than grandparents, but more than children. Children are still too young to value memories, compared with their grandparents and parents.

It is obvious that older people value material objects least of all, and immaterial objects the most. Parents, as the working group, value material things like furniture most. Children give amusement, like watching television, the highest value.

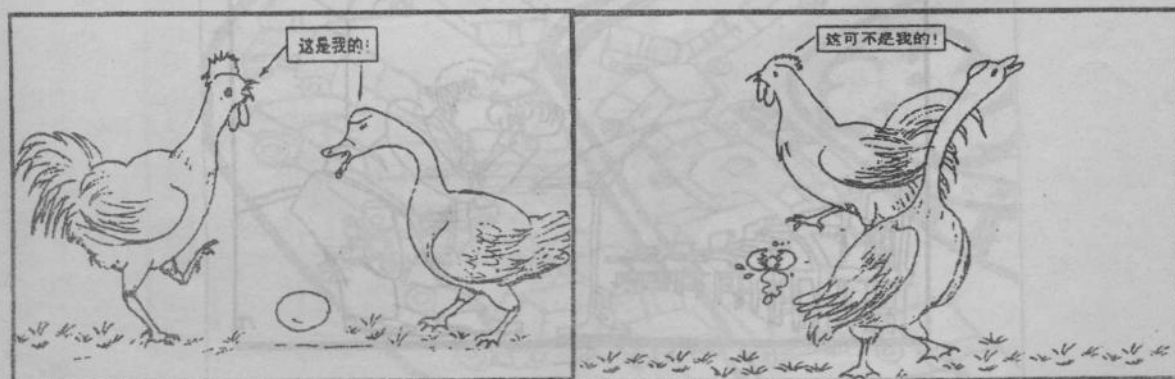

The above caricature consists of two sarcastic pictures. In the first picture, a hen and a duck are fighting fiercely for a new-laid egg. They are shouting at each other: 'it's my egg'. In the second one, since the egg is broken while grabbing, both of them intend to flee away. This interesting caricature is a vivid reflection of some people's attitudes towards achievement and failure.

Whenever there's an achievement, some people will go to extremes to capture it as their own, just like the two creatures fighting for an egg. It is quite possible that they may deceive most of the public. It's obvious in daily life that some are much more inclined to take advantage of the success of other people rather than to work hard by themselves. This phenomenon is dangerous to the entire society because people may become reluctant to work, simply waiting for the opportunity to share the others' achievement.

On the other hand, whenever there's a problem, the others tend to shrug off their responsibility, just as what the hen and duck have done when the egg is broken. It's shameful for those who escape from their duty when something wrong happens. Such an attitude is especially harmful because it can damage traditional virtue of the community on the whole. The pending problems can probably lead to even worse consequences.

As Chinese citizens, we should criticize any biased attitudes which are detrimental to society. Positive attitudes towards achievement and failure are indispensable for the development of our mental health.

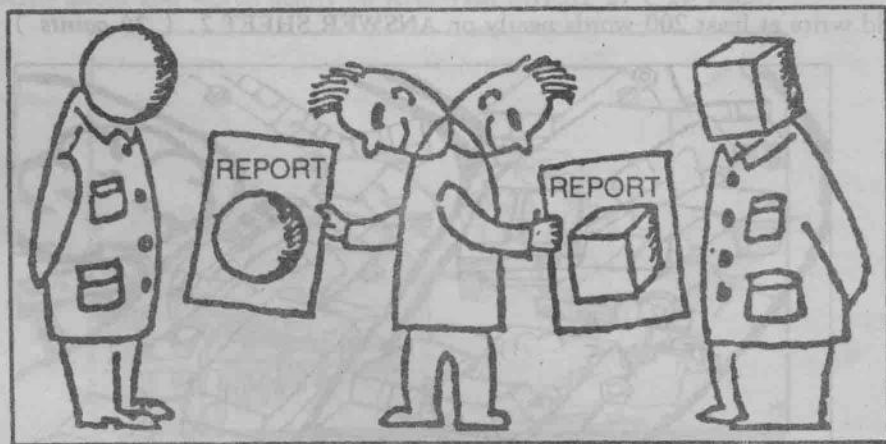

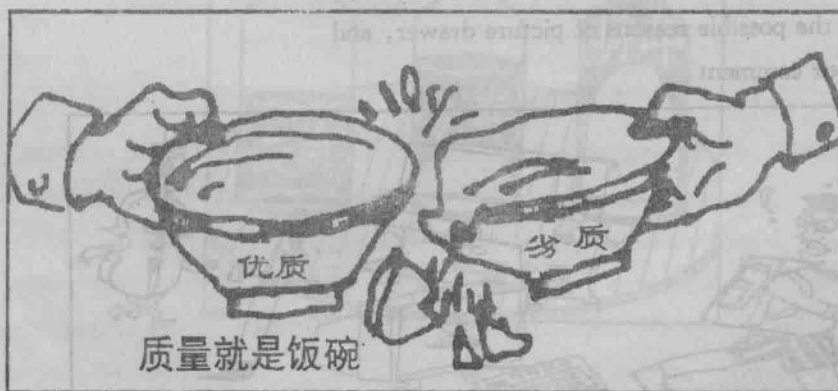

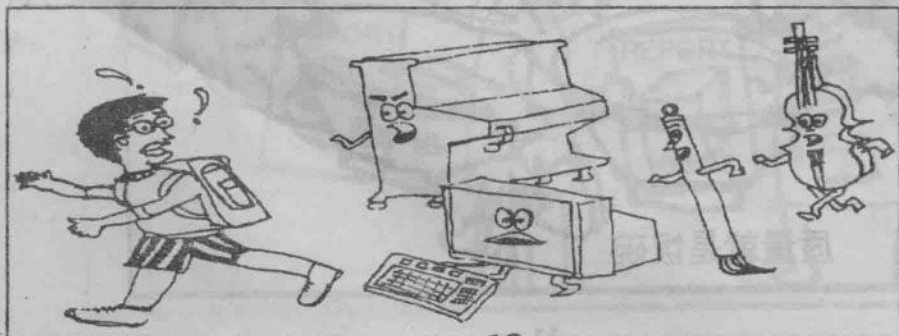

Expecting Too Much of Children

The cartoon given above just features a familiar sight: a terrified pupil with a very big bag stuffed with textbooks is on the way to school. And he is closely followed by additional courses, such as learning piano, violin, calligraphy and computer. Typically, we find that there is a sign that education of children has become the number one responsibility of parents in China. The parents imagine a road to success: the more knowledge their children learn, the brighter future they will have. So on average, parents may spend 300 yuan a month on their child's education.

And what results have these over-learning requirements obtained? A large number of parents still take for granted that spending more on their child's acquisition of musical instruments and computer will result in higher scores. Merely through drilling children to do excessive practices can these parents have too high expectations of their children(望子成龙).

In my eyes, the heavy pressure put on children both at school and at home has been responsible for a decline in children's health. This, just as an old Chinese saying goes, means "Trying to help the young plants grow by pulling them upwards"(揠苗助长). In simplest terms, excessive learning runs counter to children's psychology and may to a greater extent damage the real talents that the children possess.

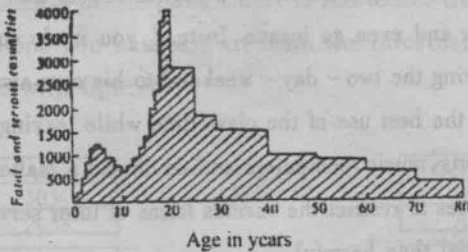
