前 言

《今日美语》是由多位美国专家、学者为非英语国家的英语学习者精心设计的美语教程。它取材于当今美国社会生活,内容新颖、生动,在语言材料的选择上强调知识性、趣味性、实用性相结合的原则,使读者在学习语言的同时吸收大量与语言相关的社会、文化等知识,并为他们创造一个轻松、活泼的语言学习氛围。

《今日美语》重视从"Sentence Pattern"(句型)、"Reiteration"(反复练习)、"Language Environment"(语境)三方面有机结合的方式进行学习。既注意打好语言基础,更侧重培养应用能力,特别是实际使用英语进行涉外交际的能力,以适应中国人世以后对外交往的需要。本书主要体现以下一些特点:

- (1)吸收了当前美语自然、随意的特点进行对话与交流,让读者在美国语言与文化的熏陶中学好口语。书中的听力材料大都取自真实的交际场景,使听者如同身临其境。经过编写者的选择与加工,这些真实的语言材料可以为不同语言能力的读者所接受,使初级和中级听力水平的读者也能感受到听懂真实英语的乐趣。听力围绕读者熟悉并且感兴趣的内容展开,力求让大家听得有兴趣,提高学习效率,最终达到学以致用的目的。
- (2)通过课文掌握句型:句型结构的分析与运用是学习美语的重要基础,本教程内容依句型的简繁,予以系统化的整理与连贯,让读者能熟悉各类基本句型,掌握句型的运用规律,通过书中的连续替换练习反复运用这些句型,让读者利用的学的宽阳顺政,套换衍变出自己所需表达的意思。
- (3)本书重点不在讲解语法知识,却把重要调法现象有针对性地融 人对话中,使读者易学、易记,而且学起来不觉枯燥,轻松上手。
