FOREWORD

This book was written to fulfill the need for a simple and direct text for Citizenship classes where the comprehension level of students may be widely varied. Although this material was compiled for use in the Chinatown/North Beach Community College Center classes, other teachers may find it suitable for use in their own classroom situations. It may also be used as a home study course. Simplicity in answering the examiner's various questions has been the main objective. Great care has been used in choosing the responses – words which the student, or applicant, would find easy to pronounce without sacrificing accuracy.

The material is arranged in a teaching sequence which generally follows the actual procedures involved in applying for and taking the examination for naturalization. For instance, if an examiner finds that an applicant cannot understand simple English, the applicant may be advised to learn more English before applying again. The examiner then would not ask further questions regarding the history or government of the United States. Hence, in this booklet, general and application questions precede those of history and government. This should not prevent any teacher, however, from teaching these parts simultaneously if so desired.

The division of words in the word lists does not necessarily follow the syllabification found in a standard English dictionary. Instead, it is a division which attempts to make pronunciation easier for the less advanced in English. Also, while prior knowledge of diacritical marks is helpful, it is not necessary. Finally, the main consideration in the entire text has been in getting the student to pass the citizenship test with minimum effort and time but with maximum results. Wherever possible, some attempt is made to instill in the individual the importance and desire of becoming a truly responsible citizen of the United States.

Some of the features of this text are in the following:

- 1. 100 Citizenship Questions listed by INS (see Appendix)
- 2. A completely-translated set of sample application forms already filled-in.
- 3. Application procedures.

This material will be revised and brought up-to-date when necessary.

Naturalization Information

I. Application for Naturalization

- A. The requirements an applicant must fulfill <u>just before</u> he applies for citizenship are as follows:
 - 1. He must be at least 18 years of age.
 - He must have lived continuously in the United States for at least 5 years after having been lawfully admitted for permanent residence.
 - He must have lived within the State for at least the last 6 months of that 5-year period.
 - 4. During the 5-year period, an applicant may make short trips outside the United States before or after he applies for citizenship; however, he must be sure that he is not absent for a continuous period of 1 year or more, preferably, not more than 6 months.
 - 5. He must have been physically present in this country for a total of at least half of the 5-year residency requirement, which is, $2\frac{1}{2}$ years or 30 months.
- B. Forms to be filled-in and items to be prepared, and altogether to be taken or mailed to the nearest Immigration and Naturalization Service Office, are the following:
 - 1. Application to File Petition for Naturalization, Form N-400.
 - Biographic Chart, Form G-325A.
 - 3. Fingerprint Chart, Form FD-258.
 - 4. Three 2" × 2" photographs taken within the last 30 days.
 - 5. Application Fee, \$60.

II. Examination

After the above application forms are submitted, an applicant will be required to take an examination. This examination will include application questions and other citizenship test questions on the history, principles, and form of government of the United States.

III. Final Hearing

A certain period after the examination, an applicant who passes the citizenship test will be notified to appear at a brief group ceremony before a Federal Judge in court. The applicant will take the Oath of Allegiance with other successful applicants and become an American citizen. The Certificate of Naturalization (Citizenship Paper) may be issued at this time, or it may be mailed shortly thereafter.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Wives or husbands of American citizens may file for naturalization after having lived in the United States for only three years after having been lawfully admitted for permanent residence.
- *2. An applicant at least 50 years of age and who has lived in the United States 20 years or more as a permanent resident need not meet the English literacy requirement when taking the citizenship examination.
- It is advisable to have copies made of the Form N-400 and Form G-325-A so that applicants know the statements they have made and which the naturalization examiner may ask them to confirm when they take their citizenship test.
- 4. Information may be obtained from the immigration officer whether Form N-402 (yellow) or Form N-600 (white) is required on behalf of any minor children's naturalization or citizenship requirements. Such forms may be obtained at this time, at the designated office, usually in the same building, or at INS.
- New law since late 1979. An applicant thus exempt from this English language requirement may take the examination in any language wished.

入籍手續簡介

- 1. 申請入籍之資格與手續:
 - A.入籍之基本條件:
 - 1.申請人必需滿十八歲
 - 2.需爲台法進入美國作永久居留者並連續居住美國最少五年。〈在呈送申請表 前〉
 - 3.申請人必須在連續居住之五年中最後之六個月住在申請入籍之省份內。
 - 4.在五年期內,申請人可以在呈送申請表前或後出國作短期旅行,但不可一年或以上,最好每次不超過六個月。
 - 5.申請人必須在連續居留之五年中最少一半時間是實際住在美國境內,即兩年半 或卅個月。
 - B.入籍所必須填妥之表格和必須呈送之證件如下:
 - 1.N400號之表格
 - 2.自傳資料表格(G325A)
 - 3.打手印卡
 - 4.三張2寸×2寸之近照(卅日內照的)
 - 5.付申請費60元
- |[. 面試:

在申請入籍表呈送後,申請人會獲通知携同面試之證件應試。(携同面試之證件及 費用,已列明在另一頁上。)

Ⅲ. 宣誓:

面試合格後,申請人會獲宣誓通知信。一般面試台格之申請人會 到指定的法庭宣誓成爲公民,公民證將當面頒發或短期內由郵局寄到。未成年之兒 童若隨父母申請入籍,應該填N402黃色表格或N600白色表格,該等表格可向移民 局索取。

另外的資料

- 1.籍民之配偶在台法淮入美國作永久居民三年後可申請歸化入籍。
- 2.如申請人是五十歲或以上而爲合法進入美國作永久居留者,並居住美國最少二十 年則考試時不需要識寫讀或講英文。可以用中文或任何語言考試。
- 3.填安之申請入籍表N400及G325A應複印存底以便面試時考官抽查答用。






