



PREFACE

In order to ensure the best performance of athletes and complete success of the Beijing Asian Games, TDOC (Transportation Department of the Organizing Committee) has worked out an efficient and accurate transportation service plan to provide transportation service for athletes, coaches, doctors and officials from all sports delegations. (They are hereafter referred to as "athletes")

Period of transportation service provided by TDOC will be from Sep. 8 to Oct. 10, 1990, including:

Airport and Railway Station Transportation upon arrival and before departure.

Opening and closing ceremonies' transportation

Shuttle-Buses for athletes to the training and competition sites.

Shuttle-buses for athletes-spectators.

Vehicles assigned to sports delegations.

AIRPORT AND RAILWAY TRANSPORTATION UPON ARRIVAL AND BEFORE DEPARTURE

Arrival:

Upon arrival, TDOC (Transportation Department of the Organizing Committee) will provide special buses to send the athletes to the Asian Games Village to get through accreditation.

Departure:

All athletes are requested to submit application for transportation one day before their departure to the Disparchers' Office at the Asian Games Village.

OPENING AND CLOSING CEREMONIES' TRANS-PORTATION

The Opening Ceremony will be held at 16:00 on Sept, 22, 1990, at Beijing workers' Sports Complex. Large buses will sports delegations by TDOC be provided for (Transportation Department of the Organizing Committee). Departure time will be informed by the Disparchers' Office at the Asian Games Village and must be observed. All delegations will take the buses collectively and orderly. The name of the sports delegations and order number of the buses will be strikingly attached to each bus. Every athlete should board the bus bearing his own delegation's name. Upon arrival to the main stadium the buses will be parked at designated parking lots. After the ceremony, the athletes will board their respective buses at the same parking lots and come back along the same route.

The Closing Ceremony will be held at 19:00 on Oct, 7 at Beijing Workers' Sports Complex. Departure time of Buses for the ceremony will be informed by the Disparchers' Office at the Asian Games Village, the same transportation service will be provided.

TRANSPORTATION FOR ATHLETES TO THE TRAINING SITES

The atheletes will have their training in accordance with the time arranged by CDOC (Competition Department of the Organizing Committee). To meet the special need of team competitions such as FB, VB, BB, WP, SB, BA, CY and KA, special buses will be provided for their training use. Sport teams of team events must submit application for using vehicles one day in advance befor 18:00 to Dispatchers' Office at AGV (the Asian Games Village) when the number of trainees may be fixed. Special bus stops for atheletes of team event will be located at the west side of the AGV, with stop boards strikingly marked with their symbolic letters.

There will be shuttle-buses for all athletes to training sites with the exception of those of team events. Please consult the time-table of shuttle-buses for athletes to training sites. The shuttle-bus stops will be located at north-side of the AGV with the stop-boards being marked with capital letter "B".

TRANSPORTATION FOR ATHLETES TO COMPETITION SITES

Competition Shuttle-Buses will be provided in accordance with the Asian Games Program. The Shuttle-Buses will directly travel to the designated competition sites one hour before the start of the competitions. Within 60 minutes after the competitions there will be shuttle-buses coming back to the AGV (Asian Cames Village). Please refer to the time-table of shuttle-buses to the competition sites. Sport teams of team events must submit application for using vehicles befor 18:00 one day in advance of their competitions to the Dispatchers' Office at AGV.

The stops of special buses for team event will be located at the west side of the AGV with stop-boads being strikingly marked with their symbolic letters.

TRANSPORTATION FOR ATHLETES-SPECTATORS

TDOC (Transportation Department of the Organizing Committee) will provide athletes—spectators with shuttle—buses according to the Asian Games Program. The shuttle—buses will directly travel to different competition sites except the following three sites: Beijing Golf Club, Jinhaihu Aquatic Sports Centre, Gymnasium of the Natitional Olympic Sports Centre.

The athletes-spectators will take these shuttle-buses at the north side of the Asian Games Village, the stop-board will be marked with capital letter "C".

VEHICLES ASSIGNED TO SPORTS DELEGATIONS

During the Asian Games, insuring all delegations convenient conditions, the TDOC (Transportation Department of Organizing Committee) will gratis assign a limited number of vehicles to sports delegations for their convenience according to their person No as follows:

Service period will start from Sept. 8 and end on Oct. 10, 1990. Application for above mentioned vehicles must be submited one day in advance to the Dispatchers' Office at the Asian Games Village. Delegations concerned may rent taxi or charted taxi at their own expenses if they consider number of assigned vehicles insufficient.

TAXI

The taxi in Beijing is widely spread and available at every major hotel. The taxi service stations are set up at all BC area in the City. During the Asian Games taxi service station will be set up at MPC, IBC, Asian Games Village and all competition sites. The taxi service is available round the clock.

The per km basic fare note is strikingly attached in each taxi-cab. The basic fare is about 1.2 yuan per km for car and 1.8 yuan per km for minibus varying according to the state and type of the vehicles.

Short-time rent of taxi:

- 1. Fare ratio starts from 2 yuan plus fare of minimum mileage of 4 km plus fare for real maleage. 50% extracharge of deadhead kilometers is added to the mileage exceeding 20 km on single trip, but in round trip with OD distance less than 2 km the deadhead extracharge is not needed. 10% surcharge is added when the taxi service is rendered between 23:00–5:00. Waiting time requested by rider is added to the fare, up to 5 minutes equaling 1 km for car, and up to 10 minutes equaling 1 km for minibus.
- 2. Method of payment

Please pay the driver the sum showed on the counter in FEC (except the home media), but tip is not expected.

Charted Taxi Service

1. Fare Ratio

Minimum mileage is 120 km for car and 100 km for minibus. Extra mileage should be paid according to basic fare per km. Daily fare=minimum mileage×basic fare per km×130% extracharge for charted car service.

Operation time for charted taxi service is from 8:00 AM to 18:00 PM (including two hours reserved for drivers' rest and meal).

Service exceeding operation time is charged 3 yuan extra fare per hour for both car and minibus. Exceeding time less than half an hour is counted as half hour and as one hour when it exceeds half an hour.

2. Method of payment

Payment is calculated on the basis of service days, and must be payed in FEC (except the home media).

3. How to get charted taxi sevice. .

Application for charted taxi service can be made at taxi service offices in the Asian Games Village.

Beijing is in possesion of over 200 bus and trolley lines linking all parts of the city. The operation time of buses and trolleys in centre of the city and near suburbs is generally from 5:00 AM to 23:00 PM. The distance between stops along bus and trolley lines are compara-

Subway:

The subway in Beijing consists of two parts, the straight line and the circle line. The straight line is from Pingguoyuan station to Fuxingmen Terminal, including 12 stations with a total length of 16.9km. It takes 28 minutes to ride through the line.

The circle line includes 18 stations with a total length of 23km. It takes 40 minutes to ride through the line.

During the Asian Games, the media personnels can gratistake the buses, trolleys and subway bearing acreditation cards.

AIRLINE AND RAILWAY SERVICE

Air China as the designated carrier of the 11th Asian Games will offer excellent and safe service for foreign friends from all parts of the world.

Air China will set up sevice offices in the Asian Games Village, Beijing Hotel, Wu Zhou Hotel and other Hotels booking tickets of both domestic and international routes for friends from all countries and regions. All passengers who want to buy tickets of international flights or confirm reservation must hold valid passports or certificates and are requested to do the application 48 hours in advance.

Foreign guests must pay in FEC.
