Part C CULTURAL BACKGROUND

- 1 the first precinct (第一分局):中美兩國的警察制度不同,美國是採集中制,分局是警察行政的最小單位,而無派出所的設置,我國原是採散在制。近年已改成了集中、散在混合制,即一面保留派出所與分駐所,以便就近提供服務給當地民衆,一面也將大部警力集中於分局,供分局豐活指揮運用。
- 2 a man in blue (當警察):美國警察的制服一年四季都是藍色的,所以人們稱警察為" a man in blue",至於我國的警察制服則依季節而分成黃色與黑色兩者,前者是春、夏 、秋三季的制服,後者則是多季制服。
- 3 C P R (心肺復甦法):是一種急救的技巧,可由單人施爲,亦可由兩人同時進行,常是用來搶救心跳停止或呼吸停止或兩者都停止或微弱的傷息,其中包括了人工呼吸法與心臟 按學法,兩者同時或交替著進行即爲心肺復甦法。
- 4.美國軍事的官階大致相同,故有稱之爲 Sergeant (士官) Lieutenant (中尉), Captain (上尉), Major (少校), Lieutenant Colonel (中校)、Colonel (上校)等等,但我國則不然,由曹貴起是巡佐,巡官,局員,分局長,局長等等,一般說來我國的晉員可稱爲 Officer,巡佐可稱爲 Sergeant,巡官則可稱爲 Lieutenant。
