Feeding wild birds in your garden is a very good thing to do. Many species of wild birds are reducing and some species are in danger of becoming to die out and are on the list of endangered species, so every little that we do to help them survive is all to the good.

You should perfectly feed wild birds in your garden all year round. Garden birds will get used to being fed at the same time every day and will visit your garden at the time when you are likely to feed them. It is also important to put out containers of water for them to drink as well, especially during the summer months when water is scarce.

The crumb of bread is acceptable to feed wild birds as part of different diets. There are many other things you can find in your kitchen to feed the birds, such as cooked potatoes, cooked rice (without salt), apples cut in half and bananas in pieces.

You should be able to judge how much food the birds will eat and you should never leave uneaten food out overnight so as to avoid attracting mice and rats. Some people like to hang up fat balls for the birds to peck at too.

One of the best things to give wild birds is mealworms (肉 虫), especially during the breeding season when they have their babies to feed. They really love them but if you cannot bear the thought of handling live mealworms then you can buy the dried variety at your local bird food supplier.

You may think that it is only in the winter that birds need help with food but in fact a food shortage can happen at any time of the year so all year round feeding is the best thing you can do for the birds to help them survive.

Feeding wild birds and attracting them to your garden are wonderful things to do. Wild birds bring so much beauty and pleasure; it would be a very dull world without them.







第二部分→解题策略与技巧

第一节 完形填空解题策略与技巧

完形填空是一种立意新、要求高的综合语言测试题。它主要考查考生对语句的连贯性和一致性的辨识能力,以及对一定语境中规范语言成分的掌握,是对考生综合运用语言能力的检验。

完形填空的试题设计

1. 题材选择

完形填空的文章与阅读理解的文章有些不同。完形填空 材料难度低于阅读理解的材料,富含词汇、语法结构等,上下文 关系较为紧凑。

2. 题目设计

完形填空的各选项设计大多为一个单词,有时是一个短语。每小题所给的四个选项一般都属于相同或对等的词类;错误选项与空前、空后词语也大多可以构成搭配,因此有一定的干扰性与迷惑性。20个小题的80个选项中所用到的词汇或结构基本不重复,增大了考查的覆盖面。完形填空题设空以实词(即所谓信息词汇)为主,名词、动词、形容词和副词等占到全部选项的95%以上。

3. 能力考查

完形填空考查对文章的通篇理解和词汇在语境中的运用。 完形填空基本上不考查语法项目,做题时不要单纯的从语法的 角度去思考、分析,即使有些题目中有一个语法形式的题(多为 对连词的考查),也只有充分考虑上下文的逻辑关系才能得出 正确答案。

➡ 完形填空试题类型

总体说来,完形填空所测试的内容大致分为四类:语境词 汇题,固定搭配题,语法结构题,逻辑推理题。语境词汇题与逻辑推理题占绝大多数。

1. 语境词汇题

完形填空对词汇的考查在很大程度上与上下文的语境有 关,也就是填入的单词要依赖于试题的上下文,从已知信息中 推论出未知信息,同时要注意填入的单词和周围单词的语义搭 配问题。

1) 原词复现

原词复现是指相同的单词在原文中反复出现,达到文章衔接的目的。做题时可利用这种衔接方法找到要填入的单词在原文中的复现词,这样就找到了试题的答案。以湖南考卷为例:

Behind our house is the start of a fascinating trail (小径). This trail is one of the old roads that wind through untold miles of forest. My <u>36</u>, Beans, and I walk the trail frequently. Normally,

Beans sniffs alongside the trail to follow the smell of a deer track or 37 some cause known only to him.

Beans is a white dog, quite handsome and very <u>38</u>. He not only understands what we tell him, but also often makes sounds as if he were...

解析 根据第二段第一句信息 Beans is a white dog, quite handsome and...暗示,所以此题答案为 B。

2) 同义词或近义词复现

同义词复现是指相同或相近的单词在原文中反复出现,以达到文章衔接的目的。在完形填空试题中,就可以利用这种衔接方式找到要填入单词的同义词或者近义词。这也包括了同源词复现,即相同词根构成的不同词性的单词在文章中反复出现。以湖南卷为例:

One morning, we took a different route, which led us to an unfamiliar trail. I was sure this trail would eventually lead us to our familiar 40 . But, no. We seemed to be far off course. After two hours, I suddenly realized that Beans probably 41 the way home.

解析 第一句中谈到信息 an unfamiliar trail,根据语境空格处应该选择一个与 trail 意义相同的词。driveway 汽车路,车行道;crossroad 十字路口,交叉路,岔道,重大的抉择关头;highway高速公路,这些都不符合语境。所以答案为 B。

3) 反义词复现

反义词复现是指与前文中词义相反的单词在文中出现,以 达到文章衔接的目的。做题时可以利用文章的这一衔接手段 在文章中寻找要填入单词的反义词。以广东卷为例:

You have to push the door with the word "PUSH" to go out of the building and to pull the door with the word "PULL" to <u>24</u> the building. This was new to me, because we use the <u>25</u> door in South Korea. For quite a few times I failed to go out of a shopping centre and was embarrassed.

解析 从该句中信息...push the door with the word "PUSH" to go out of the building 可知 the door with the word "PULL"是相反的,所选词与 go out of 互为反义词。所以答案为 A。

2. 固定搭配题

固定搭配题在完形填空中占的比重不多,它包括对动词短语、名词短语、形容词短语、介词短语的考查。我们应该在学习
