
July 2007, Beijing. To those who work in a city, the routine of going to work, buying groceries, going home, and cooking repeats itself in a simple but comfortable way.

July 2006, Kaili, Guizhou Province. A father is going home with wedding gifts from the groom's family followed by his daughter who got married earlier in the year. According to the tradition of the Miao village of Basha, Congjiang Dong and Miao Autonomous County, in southeast Guizhou Province, on June 15 of the lunar calendar, a bride should go back to her parents' to celebrate the "New Rice Tasting Festival."





September 2007, Altay, Xinjiang. Herdsmen in Xinjiang are "going home" on camelback from their summer home in the high mountain pastures to their winter home in the low land pastures. Their "mobile homes" on the backs of the camels accompany them everywhere.















I have taken over 370 photos here in Beijing, and fallen in love with different faces on different days, in different moods. – Alexander Berg






Each city has its own expression.

I was surprised by how much joy I felt in the people here in Beijing, and how open people were. There is an honesty that is so available here. – Alexander Berg
















It feels both ancient and futuristic in Beijing, all at once. Amazing and immense. – Alexander Berg
