

"Dad's going shopping," she said, giving me one of her meaningful looks.


"Why don't you go with him?"

he said, loudly.




I gave Dad another smile, not that I thought anyone would be fooled.

I looked around once more.


What if I see someone I know, I thought.

And that was when I saw Mel — my worst enemy.


She was looking right at me.

Dad's trick had worked again!






SCARRED
