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## 前言

听力是语言学习的重要环节。为了帮助广大英语学习者切实提高听力水平,我们编写了这一教材。编写中,根据国家教委关于大学英语测试题型改革(听力部分)的最新精神,设计了多种练习。

本教材注重听力基本功训练,强调基本技能的培养,内容新颖有趣,语言纯正可靠,练习形式多样。除常规选择题外,还有听写、填空、填表、是非、完句、笔答问题、图表信息转换等,使原本枯燥的听力训练,变得活泼有趣,寓学于乐。

全书共12单元,均为日常生活题材,实用性强。每一(或二)单元围绕一个主题,涉及饮食、天气、就医、住宿、询问、教育、旅游、度假、谋职、劝告等方面。

每单元分四个部分。前三部分为单句、对话、篇章等,语言难度逐渐加深,以便于学生在听懂句子、简短对话的基础上,提高语篇理解能力。第四部分为 Extra Study,这是本书很有特色的一部分。在这一部分里,我们采用了听、说、写三位一体,相互交融的综合训练方法、适当加重了听写的份量。其中 1—6 单元的 Extra Study 围绕各单元主题,展开实用句型,短语训练;而 7—12 单元则根据功能意念归纳,进行基本句型操练。这样,可以迅速提高听力水平,亦可有效地提高口头交际能力。此书还配有两套测试练习,供自测使用。

书后附有全部练习答案和听力文字材料。并配有美籍专家录音的磁带。

本教材 1-6 单元由刘爱真编写, 7-12 单元由苏建红编写。全书由东南大学外文系邹长征教授主审, 美籍专家 Mrs Bohne 协助审阅。

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
