## (中级水平考试纲要)

6、写能力,掌握 3000 个以上的英语单词、属组及相关的语法和语

# 高級木平等武要求起之,具有主义的英语交脑能力和误。可,

英语是学习科学文化知识、获取国外信息、掌握现代职业技能、进行国际交往、扩大对外开放的重要工具。为全面提高民族素质,培养21世纪人才队伍,推进江苏社会经济发展,加速实现社会主义现代化的宏伟目标,使我省干部、职工与普通公民的英语水平能适应与国际接轨的历史趋势,特建立江苏省通用外语(英语)水平等级考试制度。

通用外语(英语)水平等级考试的主要目的是测量应试者英语 知识掌握水平与使用英语进行交际的实际能力,而不是检查他们 对某一教材的学习与掌握情况。

- 一、本考试的对象包括:
- 1. 各级党政机关干部(含国家公务员);
- 2. 企事业单位(含外商独资、中外合资企业与各类涉外单位) 的干部与职工(包括管理人员、技术人员、教师与一般工作人员);

- 3. 服务性行业(指第三产业)的干部与职工;
- 4. 各类在校学生;
- 5. 社会自学者。
- 二、考试分初级(Elementary)、中级(Intermediate)和高级(Advanced)三个等级实行。每年举行两次。

考试不受年龄、学历、职业限制。

考试成绩合格者将被授予相应等级合格证书。

三、初级水平考试要求应试者具有初步的英语读、听、说、写能力,掌握 1600~2000 个英语单词及相关词组、基本的语法和语言功能项目。

中级水平考试要求应试者具有一定的英语交际能力和读、听、说、写能力,掌握 3000 个以上的英语单词、词组及相关的语法和语言功能项目。

高级水平考试要求应试者具有较强的英语交际能力和读、听、说、写能力,掌握 4000 个以上的英语单词及相关词组。

四、考试范围以本大纲规定的内容与要求为依据。试卷由听力、语法和词汇、阅读三个部分组成。中级水平考试加试翻译。高级水平考试通过者另加口试。

五、考试机构向应试者提供多种媒体组合的学习材料,包括各级考试大纲、文字教材、录音材料和少量电视课程。建议课时分别为初级80学时,中级与高级各100学时。

#### 第一部分 听力理解

## (Part I Listening Comprehension)

(30 题,30 分钟,30%)

测试考生能否听懂略慢于正常语速的句子、对话和讲话(每分钟低于90词)。

- 2. 了解内容大意;
- 3. 抓住其中要点;
- 4. 理解说话人的目的与态度。

听力测试由三类题目组成,每题均听两遍:

- 1. 听话选答:每题为一句话,听完后在四个选择项中选出与此句最适合的反应或回答。本节占总分的 10%。
- 2. 对话听答:每题为一小段两人对话,对话后第三人提出一个口头问句,听完后在四个选择项中选出正确答案。本节占总分的10%。
- 3. 短文听答: 听两段短文, 短文后共有 10 个问题, 听完后在四个选择项中选出正确答案。本节占总分的 10%。

以上各题均为多项选择题。

#### 第二部分 语法与词汇 第二部分

(Part II Grammar & Vocabulary)
(30 颢,20 分钟,15%)

测试考生语言知识的准确性。第一节为语法部分,第二节为词汇部分,各 15 题。

语法部分重点为:名词的数与格,代词,数词,介词,连接词,感 叹词,形容词与副词,冠词,动词(时态、语态、不定式)与动词句型, 各类句子基本用法。

词汇部分见初级词汇表。

以上各题均为多项选择题。

#### 第三部分 阅读理解 墨墨墨料

## (Part III Reading Comprehension)

(20题,40分钟,40%)

测试考生阅读速度与理解程度。其中包括 4 篇短文,每篇短文 长度为 200~300 词,每篇短文后附有 5 个多项选择题。具体要求 是:

- 1. 掌握短文大意;
- 2. 抓住要点与主要细节并用以推断;
- 3. 领会作者意图;

以上各题均为多项选择题。

# 第四部分 翻 译

(Part IV Translation)

(6题,30分钟,15%)

测试考生翻译水平。其中包括英译汉和汉译英两部分。英译 汉为短文,短文长度约为 150~200 词。汉译英为 5 个单句。具体 要求为:

- 1. 正确理解原文意思;
  - 2. 译文基本达意,通顺;
  - 3. 无重大语法和表达法错误。
