

# A FUN FISHING TRIP





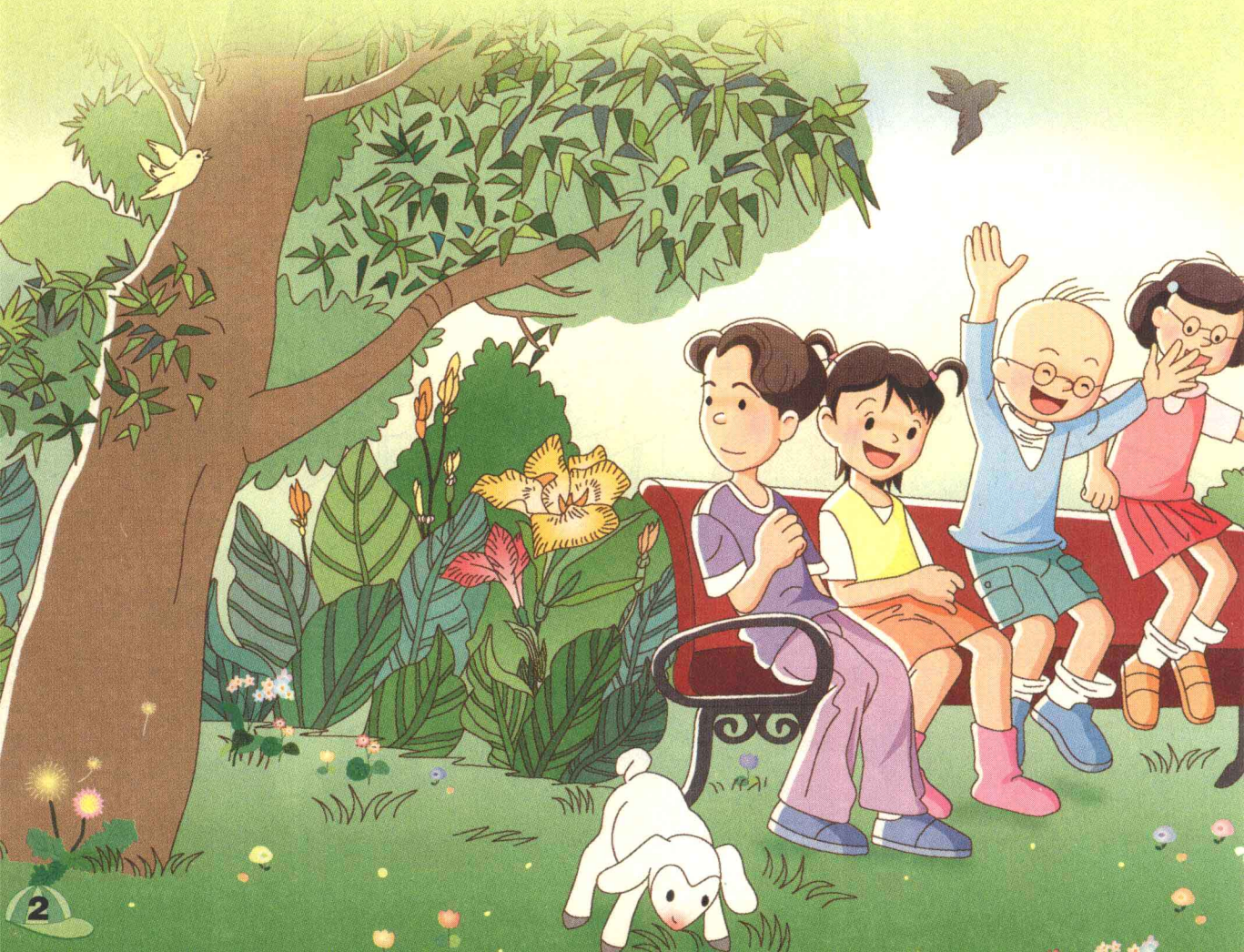
It was a hot, sunny day. Dolly and the children were thinking about what to do.

‘I’m bored. What can we do today?’ Xiaoping said.

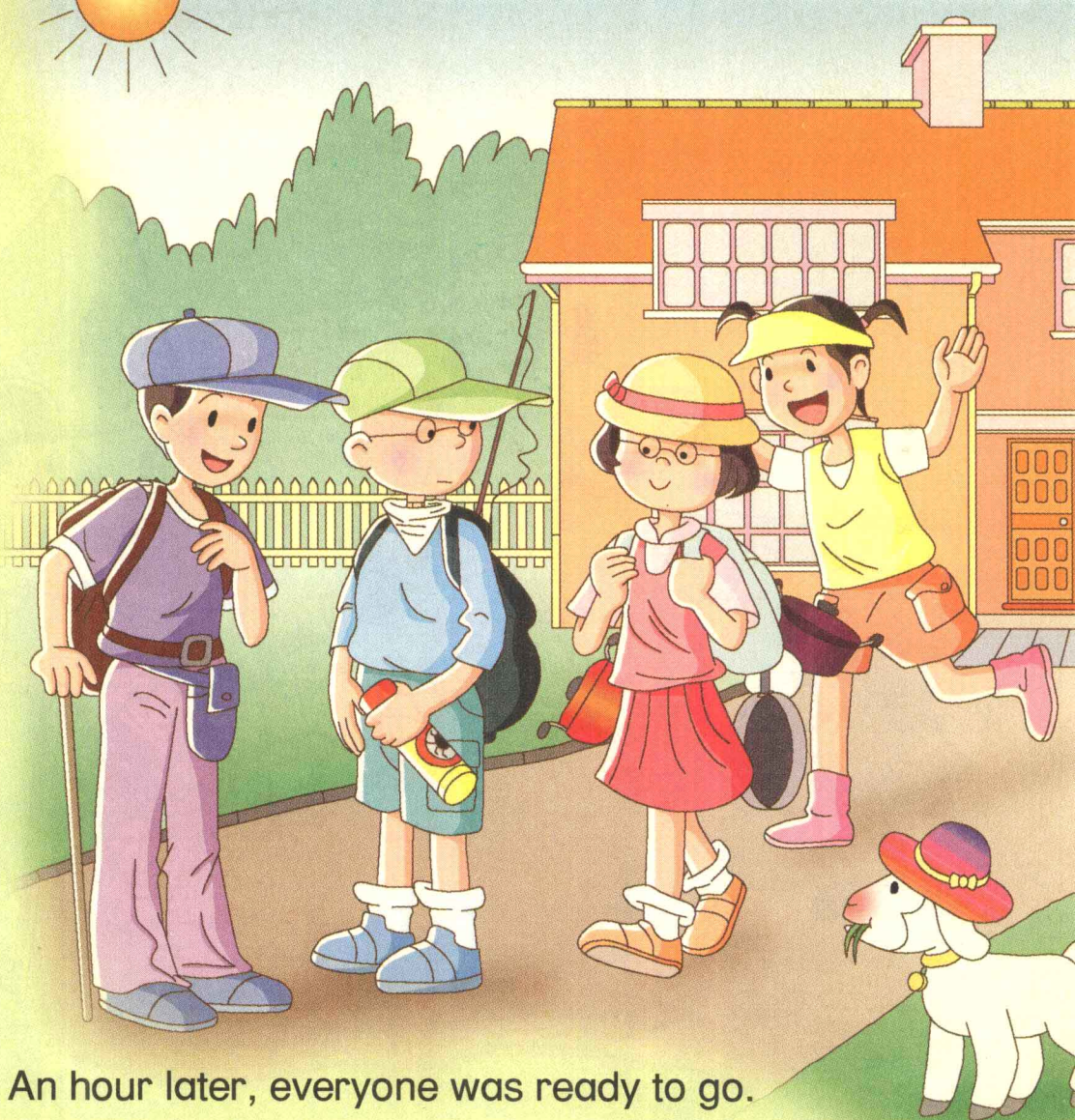
Hanwei thought for a moment. ‘Hmmm. The weather is nice. The sun is shining. Let’s go fishing,’ he said.

But the worms did not help to catch any fish.



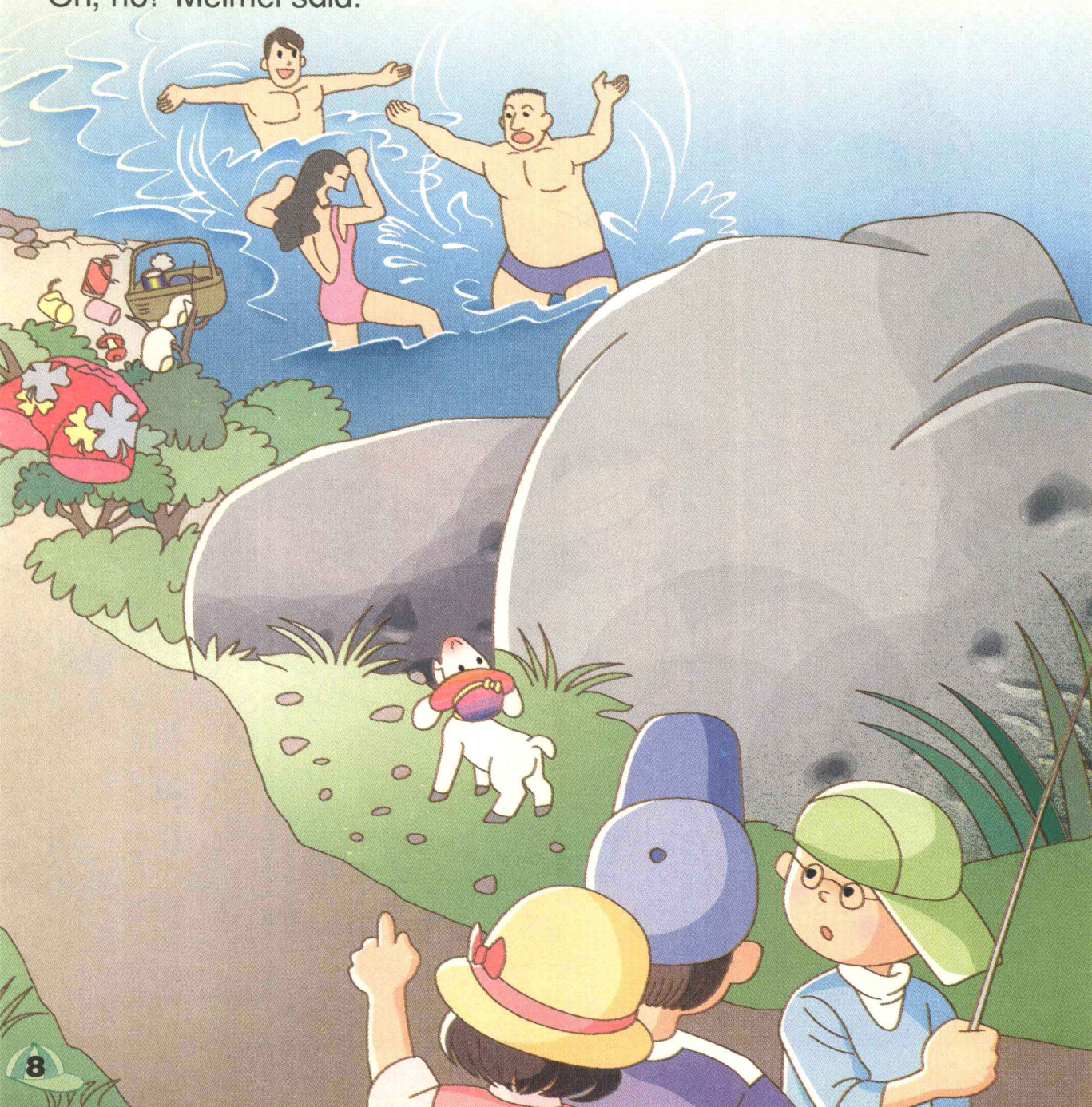


Suddenly, everyone heard a loud noise.

Xiaoping, Meimei, and Dolly walked along the river. They climbed over the big rocks.

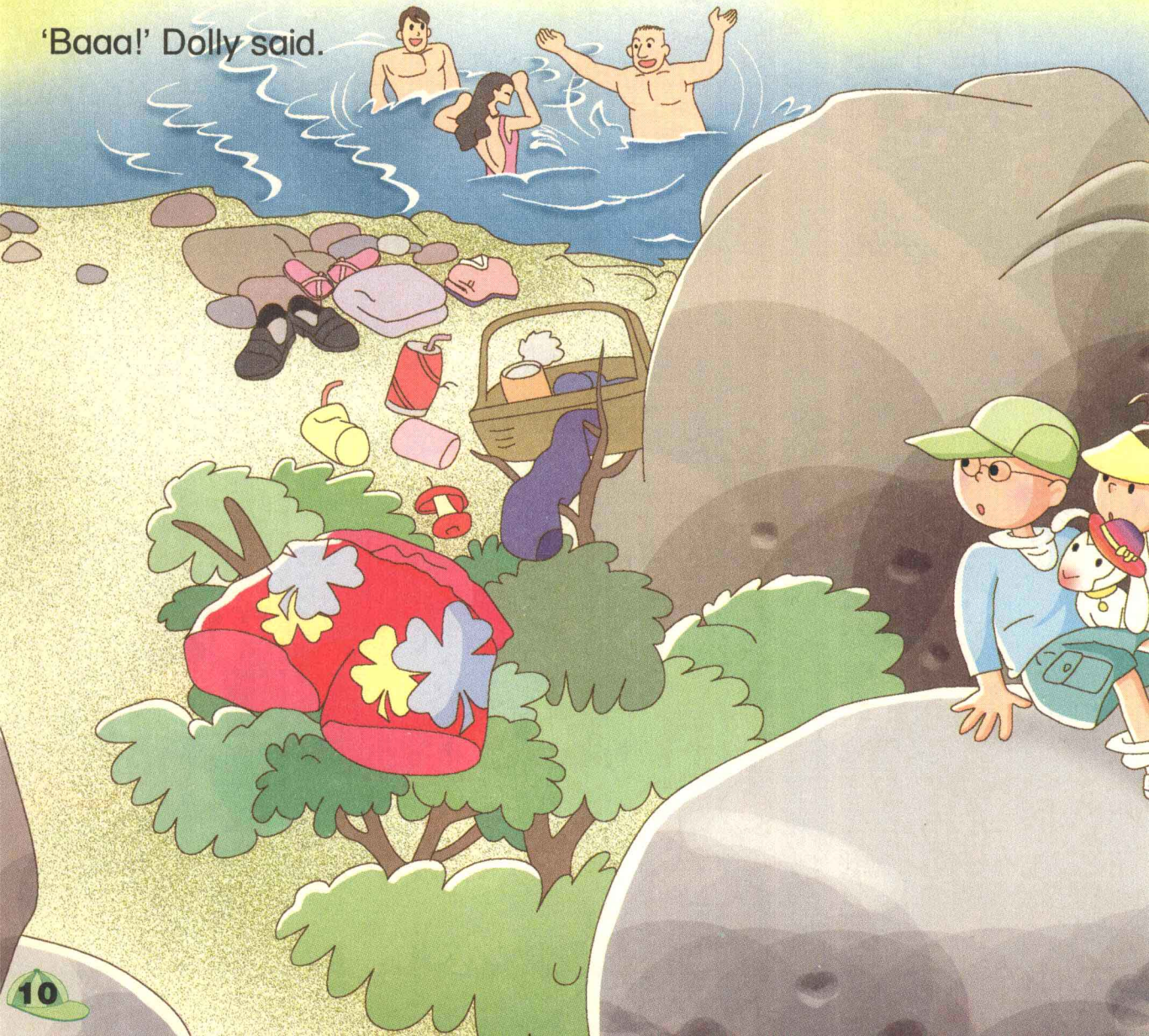
They saw three people.
