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前言

《财经英语听力》(Business English Listening)(第四册)旨在提高学生在国际经济、贸易、金融、管理等领域的实际情景中的英语听力水平。这套听力教程可作为财经和外贸院校,以及综合性大学外语和经济类专业的学生使用,也可供从事国际商务、金融、企业管理等业务的实际工作者提高英语听力时使用。

英语听力是人们英语交际能力的重要方面,是英语教学中五项基本技能之一,一直是中国学生学习英语的一个难点。提高英语听力水平能促进其他基本技能的发展,从而为培养学生综合的英语交际能力打下坚实的基础。

本教程编写过程中,在注意语言材料的真实度以及题材和体 裁广泛多样性的基础上,尽量选用较新的资料。编者曾大量参阅 比较了国外最新出版的各种原文资料和教材,从中筛选出适合中 国学生使用的材料。

《财经英语听力》(第四册)由上海交通大学外语学院俞理明副教授和周国强教授主编,上海财经大学外语系冯善萍、蒋永萍,以及复旦大学外语系陶友兰参加了编写工作。本书的编写得到了上海外语教育出版社社长庄智象教授和总编辑王彤福教授的支持和关心,并承英国文化协会英语资料中心的协助,在此一并致谢。

使用说明

《财经英语听力》(第四册)设 20 课,以每周(2 课时)使用一课计,可用 20 周。本册可供第二学年第二学期使用。具体使用应根据各校课时安排以及学生程度灵活掌握。

为有利于课堂教学,本册教程分"学生用书"和"教师用书"。

"学生用书"中每课均围绕一个题材(如 company profiles, meeting customers' needs 等),分 Part A、Part B 和 Part C 三个部分,每部分分别由词汇(Vocabulary)(包括单词、短语和专有名词)、基本结构(Basic Structures)和练习(Exercises)组成。每部分列出的词汇可由学生在课前预习或由教师上课时略作讲解。列出的基本结构是为了让学生更好地理解录音材料,也为了向学生提供与课文题材相关的常见句型,以便学生掌握,在日常口语和写作中使用。练习部分根据提供的录音资料设计了多项选择、听写、是非题和填空等各种练习。课文中出现的所有词汇的英语和汉语释义作为附录放在全书最后,供学生预习和复习时参阅。

"教师用书"参照"学生用书体例",也分 Part A、Part B 和 Part C 三部分。每部分由词汇注释(Vocabulary Notes)、基本结构(Basic Structures)、录音书面资料(Tapescript)和练习答案(Answer Key)组成。其中的词汇注释和基本结构均加了汉语译文,以方便教师备课和课堂教学时使用。

每册教程所附的录音磁带按课文顺序录制,其中练习所需的间隙可由教师在课堂教学时根据具体需要灵活掌握。
