



核心词汇考法精析



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本书是新版《GRE 核心词汇考法精析》的浓缩精华版, 开本小巧, 方便考生随时携带。

本书保留了大本书中最核心的部分——单词及其中英文释义,删除了例、派、同反义词。书中共收录 3072 个单词,涵盖历年 GRE 考试中出现频率极高的词汇以及新GRE 考试官方指南中的重点词汇。其中最后四个 List 为新增单词,以星号标注。

本书特色具体如下:

结构科学:本书共有31个 List,每个 List 包含 10个 Unit,每个 Unit 的单词量为 10个,考生可以循序渐进地进行学习,更加牢固地掌握每个单词。

释义权威: 所有单词的解释均结合 GRE 考试的常考含义进行筛选。英文释义出自《美国传统词典》(American Heritage Dictionary)及 GRE 官方指定的《韦氏大学词典》(Merriam-Webster's Collegiate Dictionary)。

结合实战:每条英文解释中均以加粗和下划线标记 出单词考点所在,便于考生迅速把握单词的特征,在平 时背诵的过程中逐步由中式思维转换为英式思维。

乱序编排:对所有单词进行乱序编排,打破常规记忆模式,巧妙记忆单词。

去年初夏第一版上架之后,很高兴收到非常多考生的来信,有认真指出纰漏的,也有希望能见到新版面市的。我们编辑团队倾听大家的意见和反馈,力争做得最好。再次感谢这些热心的考生。

考生可将本书作为备考 GRE 第一阶段的词汇书,重点关注单词的中英文释义,最大程度地避免考生对单词理解的偏差,攻克 GRE 考试中最核心的词汇,确保背诵单词的命中率。到中后期,可以认真学习《GRE 核心词汇考法精析》,确保核心单词识记的深度。对于要参加新东方 GRE 培训班的学员,建议在培训之前至少将本书翻看一遍。
