内容提要

本书是按照大学英语四级统考听力理解部分的形式,根据《大学英语教学大纲》对四级听力的各项要求和指标而编写的模拟练习题集。该书内容丰富,选材广泛,知识性和趣味性兼而有之,共包括练习题十六套,320题。

本书将有助于广大考生在短期内迅速提高听力水平和应试能力。

前言

大学英语四级考试 (CET-4) 是国家教委组织的全国统一的标准化考试。自一九八七年举办以来,受到广大高校师生的普遍关注,对大学英语教学的改革起到了促进作用。

《大学英语教学大纲》(理工科本科用)对四级水平听力部分的要求是: "对题材熟悉、句子结构比较简单、基本上没有生词、语速每分钟约120词的听力材料,一遍可以懂,理解准确率以70%为合格。"而实际上,根据最近几次考试的统计,全国高校应试考生的听力平均理解准确率仅在55%左右。而对大多数考生来说,听力得分更低,从而影响了总成绩的提高。这一情况表明,加强大学英语听力教学,强化考生听力训练是十分重要的。

为了帮助广大考生迅速提高听力水平和应试能力,编者按照大纲有关听力的规定和指标编写了这本《大学英语四级统考听力练习集》(配有四盒磁带)。本书共有十六套练习,在形式上完全模拟四级统考听力理解部分的形式。每个练习包括两节: A节共十题,每题为一组对话,对话后就其内容提出一个问句; B节含三篇短文,每篇短文后有三至四个问句,共十题,为了在训练中高标准严要求,书中练习难度比实际考试略高。本书选材广泛、内容丰富、题材新颖、知识性强,适合作广大考生的复习迎考教材。

在本书编写过程中,编者得到了原在本院任教的美籍教师Milton夫妇的大力支持,四川大学外办的高勇同志对本

书的出版也做了不少工作,特此表示谢意。

由于编者水平有限,时间紧迫,书中不当之处在所难免,热情欢迎广大师生批评指正。
