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传奇

如果仅仅用"文学家、画家、教育家、社会活动家"等等世俗而平常的词语来评定罗宾德拉纳特·泰戈尔(Rabindranath Tagore,1861~1941),确实有些清浅普通,远未能道尽他那卓越的一生。这位出身于富豪之家、哲人之家、艺术之家的大师,在他八十年的人生之旅中,成就的功业甚至超过了众生几世的努力。

泰戈尔先生从 14 岁立足诗坛,写下的诗作约两千首,出版五十余部诗集,又创作了百多部小说、数十部戏剧及大量其他论著。他的诗作深受东西方名家称颂,并深深影响了世界文坛。他精通孟加拉文和英文,1913 年获诺贝尔文学奖的《吉檀迦利》(Gitanjali,孟加拉文原意为"献给神的赞歌")就是由他自己从孟加拉文译为英文的。本书因此特配了英文原作。

从青年时代起,泰戈尔先生就积极参与社会政治活动,为印度的独立而奋斗,其间虽然波折重重,但他终未气馁,并和圣雄

甘地结成了可歌可泣的友谊。同时,泰戈尔先生又致力于发展民族教育事业,并为之付出极大辛劳,取得了举世瞩目的成就。

在步入老年后,泰戈尔先生又拿起画笔,无师自通地创作了 两千余幅作品。他的作品绝大多数都没有命名,风格抽象,但意 韵浓厚。为飨读者,特邀请远赴蓬山之外的姊彤帮忙寻找泰戈尔 画作。彤在万里之外四处劳顿,终搜得百余幅画作,使我们能够 得以完成夙愿,在此书中献给读者。

另外,泰戈尔先生还谱写出数量可观的歌曲。

因此,泰戈尔先生一生的经历和功绩堪称传奇。

在他的生命中,始终洋溢着无尽的爱和正义。没有功利,没有私欲,永远是坦荡荡一颗赤子心。所以,虽然他伏拜在神的脚下,但是在民众眼中他却有着神的光耀。

当然也不能单单用"委婉、清丽、明澈"等等任何词语来评定泰戈尔先生的诗作。不,绝不能!他的诗作分明是流诸笔端的天籁,是激荡胸怀的梵音,是为世人诉说心曲的神的垂怜。

就让我们在繁忙的现世里,驻足静立、屏息谛听,感受上苍 的恩赐,让疲惫的心儿暂且安歇。
