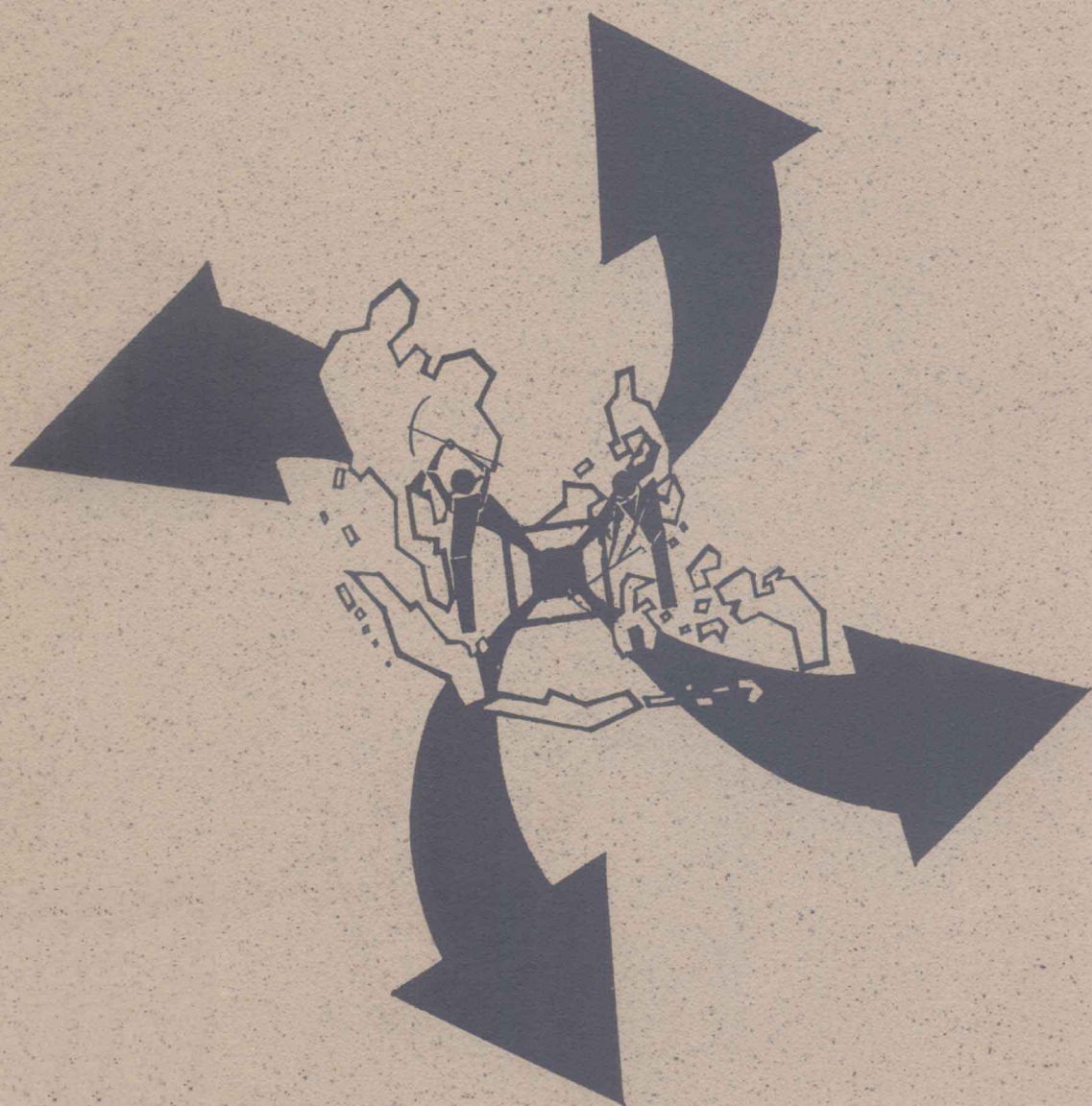

中央研究院於民國八十三年九月成立「東南亞區域研究計劃」，編者參與其中有關「東南亞人力資源與國際勞工移動」及「東南亞之社會經濟轉變」等研究項目，乃利用執行計劃之便，收集與國際勞工移動相關之近期論著，除編列書目索引外，並就各論著作成摘要彙編，成爲此冊「東南亞國際勞工移動書目及摘要彙編」。編者感謝「東南亞區域研究計劃」之經費支持，以及計劃主持人蕭新煌教授之鼓勵與協助，使本彙編得以順利完成付印。

本彙編共收集英文專論一百六十八筆，都是 1980 年代末期以後所發表的近期作品，其來源主要有兩大部份，其一爲有關東南亞地區經濟、社會與人口研究之專業期刊(如 *Asian and Pacific Migration Journal* , *ASEAN Economic Bulletin* , *Asia-Pacific Economic Literature* 等)，其二爲近年內在亞太地區所召開之國際勞工移動學術會議所發表的論文。

就內容而言，本彙編先以所有論著按作者姓氏字母順序排列，各筆資料包括作者全名、發表年份、論著標題、出處(期刊、會議或論文集)、卷期及起迄頁數，其次爲該論著之摘要(或會議之內容)，最後爲該論著之關鍵詞 (Key Word)。另外，本彙編亦按論著題目編成「標題索引」 (Index by Title)，及按作者姓氏編成「作者索引」 (Index by Author)，並進一步按關鍵詞編列索引 (Index by Key Word)，以求更方便使用。
