## 前言

词汇是学好语言的基础。测试学生英语能力的各种标准化考试, 无不直接或间接地测试考生对于词汇的掌握程度。雅思考试的题型 是多种多样的,经常是在测试听力的同时考查考生单词的拼写以及 对单词的掌握情况。因此要想顺利通过雅思考试并取得比较满意的 成绩,没有一定的词汇量是不行的。为了帮助想去英联邦、澳大利 亚、加拿大等国家留学的考生顺利通过雅思考试,我们在详细研究 往年的雅思考试试题,同时在参照大量雅思资料的基础上,对出现 频率较高的词汇进行总结,汇编成《雅思词汇 30 天突破》。本书与 其他同类书籍相比,具有以下特点。

- 1. 以"天"为单元安排学习计划,明确每天学习单词的数量, 制定出完整的突破攻略。
  - 2. 每个单词都加注国际音标,音标以英音为主。
- 3. 大学英语要求掌握的四、六级词汇全部收录。这些单词全部 是常用词,是语言交际所必需的。
- 4. 单词配有英语例句和英汉译文,这样,考生可以通过例句, 理解并记忆该词。例句具有典型性和代表性。

由于时间仓促,疏漏之处在所难免,恳请读者批评指正。
