这本书,写写停停近半年,中途曾一度打算放弃,因为我发现在课堂上滔滔不绝的我,坐在电脑前竟然不知如何下笔。这里我要特别感谢我的父母,感谢王硕、王晨,感谢陆航老师、环球雅思北京学校刘薇校长、环球卓尔编辑李晟月,正是由于你们的鼓励、期盼和帮助,才使得我有了继续下去直到完成的勇气。终于,这本书得以付梓出版!希望也相信更多学生能从中获益,达到自己理想的雅思口语考试分数!下面我就和大家一起分享《雅思口语临阵磨枪》一书的特点:

目的明确一一帮你短期备考雅思口语

本书依据British Council对于口语能力的要求,结合《CAMBRIDGE IELTS 7》和《CAMBRIDGE IELTS 8》,以历届真题为例,打破了常规的"一个答案或素材应对一个或几个问题"的传统教育模式,将IELTS全部口语话题划分为15大类,相应提炼出15个主干话题和答案,会回答这15个主干问题则同类问题基本都会作答,以一故百、大大节省备考时间。

素材新颖——口语化+新颖化

本书中的答案素材集合了我十余年在英国留学生活中的点点 滴滴与若干年来的教学经验,力争使得我们的答案给考官留下--

使用建议:

第一章《答案之外,言听计从》部分着重从考官的视角对 IELTS口语考试的发音、词汇、语法和流畅度等四个采分点阐述 了"考官在听什么、要听什么和在看什么",并针对"听不懂问 题、或者是听得懂但是不知道如何回答"和"如何能在Part 2 中 有逻辑地给出足够长的答案"等若干个最为热点的问题进行阐述 并给出相应的答案模板。

第二章《主干问题,以一敌百》部分具体如下:

- 1.【万能关键词】给出回答每类问题必须要掌握的几个关键词汇、每一篇中我们要掌握的词汇不超过10个!
- 2. 【主干问题及答案】找出每类话题中的主干问题并加以分析和回答,这个主干问题和答案非常具有代表性,主干问题的答案在"加一句话,或者减一句话"的情况下可以以一敌百,回答大多数同类问题!
- 3. 【横扫问题】这里的问题都可以用主干问题的答案在"加一句话,或者减一句话"的情况下作答。
- 4.【升级与替换】在同一场考试中,同一大类话题连续出现的频率并不高。但,如果主干问题和【横扫问题】中的问题不是作为单独的个体来出现的(同一大类话题在同一场考试中连续出现),比如考官先问: What kinds of food are most popular in China? 然后紧接着问: What kind of snacks do you like? 这种情况下我们就需要应用到【升级与替换】里面的替换答案了。MOREOVER! 如果你想取得更高的分数、说出更精彩的长句、

【升级与替换】里的(高分句式)内容会帮到你!

- 5.【试回答】通过对近期真题回顾并给出回答提示的方法, 使我们巩固和实践上面的所学!
- 6.【海外生存】看书看累了,休息5分钟,了解一下英国的文化,分享一下我在英国的日子,让你提前感受留学生活!
- 7. 【星座性格小Tip】根据你的星座性格特点,告诉你考场上 最好怎么做!

如果说最后还有什么我要表达的,我想,应该是告诉大家:这不是一本英语发音书,因为书中并没有讲每个国际音标应该如何发音,而仅仅是告诉你怎样念能让你说的英语好听;这也不是一本英语词汇书,因为书中的关键词汇不足百个;这还不是一部英语语法书,因为书中只用了"大白话"来告诉你怎么应用语法;它仅仅是一本让你在短期内尽快突破雅思口语考试的
