

Jules Verne



儒勒·凡尔纳是法国作家,被誉为"科幻小说之父"。他生于法国的南特,少年时强烈热爱航海和探险,所以他后来有不少作品都与这类主题有关。青年时,凡尔纳前往巴黎学习法律,后来开始了文学创作。他对科学和地理发现的兴趣促使他将乘坐热气球到非洲探险的可能性写成小说,这便是《气球上的五星期》。这本小说的巨大成功激励了凡尔纳,之后他笔耕不辍,创作了数十部优秀的作品。他的小说

集已知的科学发现和幻想式的冒险于一身,准确地预见了许多20世纪的科学成就和发明,如直升机、潜艇、登月技术,等等。

儒勒·凡尔纳的科幻小说总题为"在已知和未知的世界漫游", 其中较著名作品还有《海底两万里》、《格兰特船长的女儿》、《地心游 记》、《从地球到月球》,等等。



提高英语阅读能力

第一步: 避免不必要的阅读干扰, 抓住关键词汇。

在阅读中,练习通过抓住句中关键词来把握整句的核心意义。如果你不认识某个单词,试着猜猜它的意思,不要马上就去查词典。培养根据上下文推测词义的能力非常关键,因为上下文是判断单词意思的重要途径。之后再通过查词典检查其释义。

第二步: 切分长句。

本书的正文部分是由长句拆分成的短句构成,便于初学者阅读。当你发现自己开始不满足于不断分行的短句时,就说明你的阅读水平已经提高了,可以阅读更高级别的图书了。

第三步: 经常性大量阅读。

想学好英语并没有捷径。只有那些进行大量阅读的学习者才能登上语言学习的顶峰。如果你经常大量地阅读英语作品,相信你的英语水平会有一个令人惊喜的提高。


