英语中介词(prepositions)和小品副词 (adverbial particles)的使用方法比较难于掌握,因为这两类词的用法和所表示的意义很多,有的差别极其细微,不加以科学的分析和比较不易区别。目前国内外出版的英语词典和有关英语 介词及小品副词的专门书籍很多,但一般对这两类词的用法和释义阐述得都不够完全、系统。为了帮助国内翻译、教学人员和中等水平以上英语学习者了解掌握英语介词和小品 副词的系统知识和用法,我们特编写了这本词典。

我们在这本词典里共收录了 66 个常用或比较常用的介词 (其中 amid/amidst, among/amongst, till/until, to-ward/towards 等各列为一个词条,实际共 62 个词条),包括它们的副词用法。对于不常用或用法十分简单的介词(如 aboard, apropos, atop, save, than, via) 或与其他词类界线不太清的介词(如 concerning, considering, following, pending, less)以及没有介词功能的小品副词(如 away, back)等,未加以收录。

本词典的编写在词义的编排划分上系以《牛津英语大词典》(The Oxford English Dictionary)为主要依据。对该词典中过于古老生僻,尤其是一些废弃条目则未予采用。此外我们还参考了《韦氏新国际词典》(Webster's Third New International Dictionary),希尔编《介词及小品副词》(Prepositions and Adverbial Particles by L. A. Hill)及伍德编《英语介词成语》(English Prepositional Idioms by Frederick

T. Wood) 等三本辞书,并将其释义简单明了、例句贴切易懂等优点尽量地吸收到本词典中。偶有词义《牛津英语大词典》 未收而见于后三者时,我们也斟酌情况补充到本词典中。这样既丰富了本词典的内容,又更适合于广大英语学习者的查阅使用。

本词典所给的释义力求文字简明,含义准确,避免模棱 两可的解释或一般化的汉语对等词;在必须使用汉语对等词 时也尽量使用代入法,使读者获得明确的概念。例句除来自 上述四种辞书外,并从若干英美出版的工具书和语言、文学、 历史等读物以及报刊杂志中广泛收集典型文句充做例证,句 末并用代号注明出处(详见"例句出处及代号")。《牛津英语 大词典》中的例句大多富有文采,但缺点一是年代较老,二是 艰涩难懂,用作例证效果较差,所以我们对例句是尽量多从 其他来源,而少从《牛津英语大词典》中选用,尤其对其中所 列的十七世纪以前的例句采用时尤为慎重。

### 体例说明

### 一、词条:

- 1. 以每个介词为一个词条,按字母顺序排列。
- 2. 一般词条包括介词、副词、词组三个部分,用大写英文字母 A、B、C 标明。少数词条只有两个部分: A. 介词,B. 词组,或A.介词,B.副词。
- 3. 词条内容编排,注意系统性。在较大的词条内,介词和副词两部分各按词义和用法分 I,II,III,……等大项。大项下面分 1,2、3、……等条;小词条不分大项,只列小项。以条为词条的基本单位,每条主要由释义和例句组成,按 A. 介词,B.副词顺序连续排列,如 OUT 词条有词义 1—73 条,其中1—4条为介词,5—73条为副词。词组部分以每一词组为一条,不列顺序号。

#### 二、头词:

每一词条以介词为头词。头词用黑体大写字母排列,自成一行,不加标点,一般不加说明。

### 三、释义:

词条下的每条词义或词组均先给释义后列例 句。释义有单一释义或几个相近的释义并列在一起。释义采取 汉 语解释或汉语对等词,或在汉语解释后加对等词等方式。释义力求准确清楚,先给基本词义,后加引伸词义;词义相近的各条尽量排列在一起。

### 四、例句:

每条词义一般配备例句3-5个。例句采用典型明了的

句子或短语,通常先列短语后列句子;有少数生解词义所列出的例句可能不足三个。词组一般配备一个例句,含义较多者例句相应增加。例句均排列在释义后面,并用代号注明出处,如注(E)者表明该例句出自《牛津英语大词典》。各代号所指的资料名称见"例句出处及代号"。各例句后均附译文。个别例句原文中有古体字者均改为今体字。

#### 五、词组:

词组包括成语(idioms)和一般词组(phrases)。词组的排列顺序不分介词或副词用法,由前置介词构成的词组列在前面,后置介词或副词构成的词组列在后面;前置与后置均按词组的字母顺序排列。

### 六、符号:

( ) (圆括号)用于:

- 1. 补充说明。如: (指运动)从……里到外边;从……出来。 沿着……(河等)向上游。
- 2. 括出可增添部分。如: stand out(against sth.)(在……衬托下面)显眼。
- 3. 括出例句出处(用代号表示)。如:

- 4. 用于可以类推的词的外边。如: for my(his,etc.)part 对我(他等)来说
- 5. 在释义中引用的例词例句,其译文有时放在圆括 号内以便于与释义本文分开。

1. 注明词的使用地区、专业或修辞色彩。如:

2. 注明例句原文中没有,但为便于理解或语法上的需要而由引用者添加的词语。如:

He felt hemmed about by forces that he was powerless to overcome. (O) 他感到已被不能战胜的各种势力所围困。

The rights of the individual states are hedged about with so many safeguards that the central Government has practically no real power over them at all. (H) 各个州都把自己的权益层层 保护起来,以致中央政府实际上对它们没法实施真正的管辖。

16. 向四周,朝四面八方。

'Tis time to look about. (I) 是审时度势的时候了。
