#### 前言 Foreword

时代在发展,中国在进步,英语作为最重要的语言之一,已成为我们生活中不可或缺的部分,良好的英语水平已成为现代人走向世界的通行证。

众所周知,英语是世界上词汇量最丰富的语言之一,掌握其中普遍存在的同义词与近义词,便成为措词精确、表达丰富的重要前提,也是英语学习和应用的必经之路。鉴于此,我们特组织了大连外国语学院的著名专家、学者,为广大英语学习者编写了这本《英语同义词、近义词词典》。

本书在策划与编写过程中,主要遵循了以下原则:

★收词适当,紧跟时代。英语中的词汇浩如烟海,本书在编写过程中最大限度地以人性化、科学化设计为前提,按词汇的重要程度及使用频率进行归纳和整理,所选词汇均为紧跟时代发展的最新词汇。

★近义词汇,全面收录。本书中所列词汇,力求做到与其意思相同相近相关的单词及短语全部收纳,最大程度上丰富了学习使用者的同义词近义词词汇量,使其在选词达意时可以信手拈来,灵活运用。

★注明音标,方便记忆。本书中每个词条都注明了音标, 便于读者边读边记,在记忆单词的同时,可以根据标准音标学 习和纠正单词读音,由此避免了英语学习中只会看不会说的现 象出现。

★开本较小,便于携带。本书在编写过程中,充分考虑到 当今快节奏的工作与生活给学习时间及阅读场所带来的限制, 开本设计较小,方便读者携带与阅读。
