1. Airline companies are famous for enforcing strict grooming regulations on their flight attendants. Although the degree of rigidity may differ according to each company, the majority of flight attendants file complaints about the regulations with the union for various reasons.

One such complaint is that grooming policies are too irrational. There is no point in enforcing a regulation that only interferes with work while bringing no satisfaction to the customer. To take an example, certain airlines forbid their stewardesses to wear red lipstick in the cabin, and it is difficult to see how the color of lipstick can hinder them from carrying out their task.

Another problem with rigid grooming regulations is that they are subjective without clear standards. For example, when a flight attendant is penalized for braiding her hair, the grounds for punishment are actually unfounded. In other words, claiming that braids are prohibited because they do not look "neat" does not make a case without defining what "neat" means.

2. Job sharing refers to a practice of dividing the responsibilities of a full-time work between two workers. Although it is not a popular business practice, job sharing is experimented with by some major companies for its benefits.

For the employers, job sharing removes the burden of having to lay off employees when the company is experiencing trouble. Instead of firing hundreds of employees, everyone can reduce their working hours and put in extra effort until the company turns around. In fact, this has proven to be successful with many mining companies where workers were highly supportive of each other.

Sharing jobs can help employees just as well. Many companies are reluctant to grant professional jobs to parttimers, but there are many part-timers looking for professional jobs. The most representative group of this case is professional moms. With kids to take care of, today's mothers, especially single mothers, need to juggle their professions and their kids. Allowing them to work reduced hours by sharing work can definitely allow them the break they need.

3. Thanks to amazing scientific leaps in genetic engineering, food crops can be grown against many adversities for efficient production. Genetically modified foods are foods produced from genetically modified organisms in which the genomes are genetically altered, and many scientists claim they provide the solutions to many agricultural problems.

One such adversity overcome by genetically modified foods is food decay. One of the first genetically modified foods to be marketed to the public was tomatoes. When they were first sold in 1994, consumers were willing to pay four or five times more than the average price of tomatoes because they were more long-lasting. For the same effect, tomatoes could be preserved for a long time and transported for long distances.

Many foods now can be altered to withstand strong pesticides that could not be used before because they damaged many crops. Now through genetic modification, insect-free foods can grow to be harvested after being sprayed with stronger pesticides which kill harmful pests such as maggots and beetles.

- 4. There is a growing concern about the rising gap between the economic classes in the country. However, there is a greater concern of the rich getting healthier while the poor are getting sicker. Something must be done to address this issue, and the way to deal with it is through national health insurance.

Just as the government has the duty to educate the public, the government has just as much duty to insure

the public. In America alone, over 45 million people are not covered by health insurance. Proposed tax cuts and mandating people to have private insurance are not the answer. By nationalizing health insurance, the government must take on the role of protecting the public's health, especially for those who cannot afford it.

With the absence of national health insurance, medical costs in the country are reaching the ceiling, and the households with low income are not able to meet the cost. If the government appropriates enough funds for national health coverage, any expansion in medical costs can be subsidized by the government. Also, because the money comes out from the government's pockets, appreciation in medical costs will be kept in proper check.

5. For many small businesses, handing out flyers in the street has been a popular method of advertising. However, the local authorities should ban this practice because it is not only ineffective but also destructive to the local environment.

Small business owners need to understand that street flyers do not help promote their business. In the city, it is common to find people walking around with paper advertisements in their hands. But do they actually read what is on them? The answer is no. According to a survey, more than 70 percent of people accepting the flyers answered that they did not take the time to read the contents of the flyers, and over 80 percent of the people rejecting flyers responded that they would rather not take the flyers because they end up as garbage.

What's worse, flyers distributed in the streets pollute the environment and become a real eyesore. On average, a small business hands out from 400 to 700 flyers at a time. If this is multiplied by the number of businesses that decide to spread these advertisements on the same day, the number adds up to more than a million flyers covering city streets. In addition, all these flyers come at the expense of valuable life-saving trees in forests.

- 6. Using marijuana on patients for medical purposes has long been controversial. However, this is a controversy that has unnecessarily dragged on, for the benefits gained by patients are definite whereas the harms are only speculative.

The evidence is overwhelming that marijuana helps alleviate extreme symptoms suffered by patients. The types of symptoms are pain, vomiting, and depression endured by patients suffering from cancer, AIDS, and multiple sclerosis. For patients who are terminally ill, marijuana as medicine will remove a lot of painful burdens.

For those who argue that marijuana will get patients hooked, they are only worrying about a negligible portion. According to research, only about 9 percent of marijuana users become dependent on it. Contrarily, 15 percent of drinkers develop dependence upon alcohol and the figure is over 30 percent for smokers.

7. FDI, or foreign direct investment, is a type of investment where a company transfers its production and/or research overseas, thereby directly investing in the host country. Although this is a global practice among multinational businesses, it is met with strong opposition from many groups for several reasons.

Perhaps the strongest opposition comes from the fear that the entrance of multinational companies will threaten local companies. The multinational companies with the capacity to transfer production overseas are organizations with enormous capital and management know-how. Such companies will be no match for many local firms, especially in emerging economies.

The second reason stems from the idea that multinational companies only invest in the host country to exploit its cheap labor and natural resources. There is a growing presence of factories constructed by multinational conglomerates in emerging economies such as Vietnam and India; however, the workers employed by these companies receive wages that are far below those received in other countries. For example, an hourly wage received by a factory employee with a 12-hour shift is a miniscule US\$1.50.

- 8. Owing to the falling price of handheld sets and rates, cellular phones are becoming prevalent not only on the streets but also in high school classrooms. However, due to disruptions reported by teachers, schools have banned leaving cellphones on in class.

Disallowing cellular phones in class has become necessary due to increasing cases of cheating using handheld devices. Students have been reported to use text messages as the main means of cheating on tests. Through these messages, students can send each other answers, especially for standardized tests for which the questions are mostly multiple-choice.

Another reason to keep cellular phones out of the classrooms comes from the fact that they interrupt the students from concentrating on the lessons. For example, a phone that accidentally goes off in the middle of a lecture because of a careless student will disrupt the class for every classmate. Even if the phone is set to vibrate, the student will be kept from focusing on the lesson as the phone vibrates in his or her pocket.
