CHAPTER NINE

INSURANCE

Introduction

Insurance is very closely related to foreign trade. People in the international trade should have a thorough knowledge of it and the ability to handle its problems. And only in this way are they able to prevent loss from its occurrence.

Insurance was originally applied to losses at sea, where risks were always great, but it is now provided to cover almost any kind of occurrence that may result in loss. As a large percentage of our trade in and out of this country goes by ship, what mainly concerns us is still the Marine Insurance.

In this Chapter we are trying to present to the students the different kinds of risks of insurance that are commonly dealt with and the customary practices.

Moreover, as foreign trade workers we should strive to win over the business of insurance, wherever favourable, as it is a form of intangible trade which helps us to accumulate foreign exchange.

Asking for C&F Terms

Dear Sirs,

Insurance

We thank you for your letter of May 10, quoting us 100 metric tons of Wool on CIF terms. We regret, however, that we prefer to have your quotations and/or offers on C&F terms.

For your information, we have taken out an open policy with the Lloyd Insurance Company, London. All we have to do when a shipment is made is to advise them of the particulars. Furthermore, we are on very good terms with them. We usually receive from our underwriters quite a handsome premium rebate at regular intervals.

In the meantime, we should be obliged if you could supply us with full details regarding the scope of cover handled by the People's Insurance Company of China for our reference.

We look forward to hearing further from you at an early date.
