

FOREWORD

Substantial and extensive developments in family law since the publication of original Volume 24 in 1966 have made it impossible to keep abreast of the law of Divorce and Separation through pocket part supplementation alone. The evolution of no-fault divorce, equitable distribution of property of the spouses, joint child custody, changes in spousal pension rights, and many other new rules have had a vital impact upon the law covered in Divorce and Separation. These changes are making themselves felt across the country as they are adopted in jurisdiction after jurisdiction. Uniform laws now affect many aspects of divorce and separation. These include the Uniform Marriage and Divorce Act, the Uniform Divorce Recognition Act, and the Uniform Child Custody Jurisdiction Act.

The nature and degree of these and other changes in the family law area compel the rewriting of Divorce and Separation in Volume 24.

The law of subjects other than Divorce and Separation covered in Volume 24 has also been completely re-examined and rewritten in the light of today's law. Old and rarely challenged doctrines, as well as matters of historical interest, have been condensed and made more succinct. The result is a more tightly written, updated and comprehensive presentation of the current law in a single volume replacing original Volume 24.
