# 出版前言

# Introduction to the World Link Video Course

Welcome to the second edition of the *World Link Video Course*, creating interesting and fun opportunities for learners to become fluent in everyday English. The video course is part of the *World Link* textbook series, a four-level core series for young adult and adult learners of English from the beginning to intermediate level. - Global Viewpoints real-life interviews in which a wide range of students and professional people from around the world present their personal views on issues related to unit topics.

I have really enjoyed working on the World Link Video Course, and I hope learners have as much fun using it. My greatest hope is that the World Link Video Course Workbook helps many learners become confident and fluent speakers of English.
