FOREWORD

In 1999 the authors of this work published an earlier title on the work of the Administrative Court in relation to criminal cases. The law which is applied to these cases is in many respects common to judicial review generally. But in a good many other respects, both procedural and substantive, it is peculiar to the criminal process. This new book is accordingly a handbook for use in civil as well as criminal cases.

Since 1999, when the original work was published, one of its authors has become Mr Justice Fulford, a judge both of the Queen's Bench Division of the High Court and of the International Criminal Court. This new work draws on his and Hugh Southey's learning and experience, in both civil and criminal cases. No book can anticipate and answer every problem, but this one valuably surveys current authority and principle and provides precedents for many of the documents that practitioners will need.

The Human Rights Act 1998 is not discretely treated but is absorbed into the main text. This is as it should be. The jurisprudence of the European Convention on Human Rights is gradually entering our own law, causing us to re-examine some accepted ideas and to accept some new ones. The voyage of discovery which I anticipated in my foreword in 1999 is not proving as stormy as some had predicted, but it is full of interest. This book will help to pilot practitioners on a sometimes tricky but always rewarding journey.

PREFACE

For any lawyer interested in our system of government there can be few more interesting areas of law than judicial review. That is because judicial review plays a critical role in our system of government.

It is a basic principle of our constitution that the executive is subject to judicial control. It ensures that the executive complies with the law made by the democratically elected legislature. If there were to be no judicial control, the executive could ignore the legislature. Judicial review is the form of procedure that is normally used to bring decisions of the executive before the courts.

In the last few years we have seen how powerful this form of judicial control can be. In particular, we have seen how it can restrict the executive in a manner that can cause the executive to resent the interference with its freedom to act. For example, much of the tension between David Blunkett and the judiciary is the result of decisions in the area of judicial review.

The restrictions on the executive are critical at a time like the present. The executive has such a large majority in Parliament that it only provides a limited check on the executive. Judicial review can at least ensure that the executive acts in a lawful manner.

We have both been privileged to practise within this area of law. It has enabled us to participate in litigation of fundamental importance to very many people. We hope that this book will give readers the basic skills to practise in this area and will assist readers to make up for any lack of experience.

There are a large number of people whom we need to thank for their assistance in the preparation of this book. First, we need to thank Jackie and Jose Luis for all their support and understanding. We also need to thank Navtej Ahluwalia, Nick Armstrong and Judith Farbey for agreeing to read proofs of this book. Any mistakes, however, are ours and not theirs.
