INTRODUCTION

Masters Abstracts International

Masters Abstracts International is published bimonthly by ProQuest and includes masters theses, Educational Specialist materials, and other projects which have been accepted for degrees by accredited institutions. These institutions are listed in this introductory section.

Entries in *Masters Abstracts International* are grouped by subject. The subject categories appear elsewhere in this introductory section. Within each subject category, entries are arranged alphabetically by author. At the back of each issue is an Author Index, with a Cumulative Author Index in the final issue of each volume.

All bibliographic data relating to a thesis or monograph appear at the head of an entry, followed by the abstract. This data includes:

- Title
- UMI order number

- Author's name
- Degree awarded
- Institution awarding degree
- Year degree awarded (or monograph completed)
- Number of pages

Researchers can order full-text copies of any thesis or monograph listed if a UMI Order Number appears after the title entry. Prices and ordering information appear elsewhere in this introductory material. UMI publishes only the abstract for some institutions, and for these no publication number is listed. In most cases, contact the institution for copy information. For schools located in Canada, write to the National Library in Ottawa, Canada.

DISSERTATION SERVICES

UMI Dissertation Services is a program of publishing, bibliographic, and copy services which enables the researcher to locate doctoral dissertations, and to acquire copies of those manuscripts published by UMI. The foundation on which these services are structured is UMI's comprehensive dissertation database, one of the largest and most widely used bibliographic information files in the world.

The Dissertation Database

UMI's dissertation database is a computerized file containing bibliographic citations to over 1.5 million North American doctoral dissertations dating back to 1861. In addition, citations to over 70,000 masters theses are included. More than 45,000 dissertation citations and 12,000 masters thesis citations are added to UMI's dissertation database each year. New citations are entered into the database each month.

There are a number of ways to search the dissertation database for citations. Following is a brief outline of UMI's Search Services.

Database and Online Search Services

Dissertations Direct is a computerized search specifically designed for collection development. By working with UMI's editorial and database experts, libraries and research centers can identify areas of special interest and create a customized collection.

Dissertation Abstracts Online electronically reproduces the full text of abstracts published since July 1980. Updated monthly, this online service includes both current abstracts and UMI's entire dissertation database dating back to 1861. As with the printed issues of *Dissertation Abstracts International*, the online service provides author-prepared summaries, approximately 350 words in length, which describe in detail the original research projects on which the dissertations are based.

With access to BRS, Data-Star, Dialog®, OCLC EPIC, and STN® online information search services, researchers can conduct a direct and immediate search of UMI's dissertation database. Researchers can order dissertation copies directly through their terminal by using the DIALOG Dialorder service or BRS ORDER or the OCLC ILL subsystem.

Dissertation Abstracts Ondisc

Researchers can now search the dissertation database independently—using *Dissertation Abstracts Ondisc*. *Dissertation Abstracts Ondisc* uses CD-ROM technology to provide information from over 1.5 million doctoral dissertations and masters theses. Researchers access this information using an IBM XT, AT, or compatible microcomputer with a minimum of 640 kb RAM.

Dissertation Abstracts Ondisc includes both bibliographic citations and 350-word abstracts for titles published since July 1980—just as they appear in *Dissertation Abstracts International*. In addition, bibliographic citations are included for dissertations prior to July 1980—dating as far back as 1861. Annual subscriptions and backfile discs are available. UMI adds approximately 55,000 new titles each year, with current abstracts delivered ondisc twice each year with your annual subscription.

Printed Reference Tools

UMI's *Comprehensive Dissertation Index* is the definitive reference source for researchers who prefer to use a printed source to conduct their search. Available in most academic and institutional libraries, *CDI* is the only definitive printed reference to almost every doctoral dissertation accepted in North America since 1861. *CDI* supplements are published annually in both library-bound volumes and on microfiche.

The landmark 37-volume *CDI 1861-1972* lists more than 417,000 dissertations under keyword headings and within a separate author index. The *CDI Ten-Year Cumulation 1973-1982* cites nearly 351,000 dissertations in a 38-volume single-source reference and the *CDI Five-Year Cumulation 1983-1987* includes over 162,000 citations in 22 volumes. Together, these powerful bibliographic tools allow access to approximately 930,000 dissertations spanning more than 125 years with just *three* separate searches. *CDI* supplements are published annually in both library-bound volumes and on microfiche.

Dissertation Abstracts International is the authoritative source for concise, author-written summaries of current doctoral dissertations. Each abstract describes the dissertation in detail, enabling researchers to isolate and evaluate research trends. Monthly issues of *DAI* include approximately 3,500 abstracts grouped by subject and printed in two separate sections: Section A—*The Humanities and Social Sciences*, and Section B—*The Sciences and Engineering*. Section C—*Worldwide* (formerly *European Abstracts*)—is published quarterly.

Masters Abstracts International, published bimonthly, provides 150-word, author-prepared abstracts of master's theses.

American Doctoral Dissertations, published annually on an academic-year basis, is arranged by subject category, institution, and author. It is compiled for The Association of Research Libraries.

UMI also makes available a number of special subject bibliographies and catalogs to assist researchers in locating relevant dissertations and master's theses. For information on subject catalogs, call 1-800-521-0600, extension 3736.

Illustrations and Oversized Maps

UMI offers detailed glossy reprints of illustrations and oversized maps included in dissertation copies. New photographic technology makes these reproductions available for research, teaching, presentation, or display purposes. Oversized maps are reproduced as 17" x 23" black-and-white glossy prints or 35mm slides. Illustrations and photographs are reproduced as black-and-white 6" x 9" glossy prints.

Dissertation and Master's Thesis Publishing

Any dissertation or master's thesis successfully submitted for a doctoral or post-doctoral degree may be published by UMI, whether or not it has previously appeared in print. No limit is placed on the age of the dissertation. For a nominal fee, UMI will film, store, and publish microform or paper copies of your dissertation or master's thesis literature. HOW TO ORDER

DISSERTATION AND MASTER'S THESIS COPIES

Ordering Information

Dissertations and master's theses available from ProQuest are indicated by an order number at the end of the entry. When ordering dissertation or master's thesis copies from UMI, include the entire order number, author's last name, complete title of dissertation or thesis, format and type of binding wanted, billing name and address, and shipping name and address.

If *no* order number appears at the end of the entry, the dissertation or thesis is not available from UMI. For further information, contact the institution granting the degree.

Dissertation and Master's Copies

All doctoral dissertations, master's theses, and other research documents published by UMI are preserved on film. The original manuscript is returned to the author or to the institution awarding the degree. When an order is placed through UMI, the complete research document is individually reproduced on paper or in microform, using the master film copy. This is called *on-demand publishing*. On-demand publishing allows UMI to store vast amounts of information materials in its vaults while retaining the capability of publishing in the format of choice as soon as an order is placed.

- 2) Hard cover paper copies
- 3) 35mm positive microfilm
- 4) 98-page positive microfiche (for all titles published from 1976 forward)
