

NATIONAL MINIMUM WAGE ACT


KEY CASE

CARMICHAEL V NATIONAL POW.

Mrs Carmichael worked as a guard on a "group of persons" basis, showing group discipline. She worked some hours more than others, wore a company uniform, was provided with a company vehicle, and enjoyed many of the benefits of employment. The question for the court to determine was whether she was employed "under an umbrella" or "global" employment. The court held that she was employed under an umbrella.
