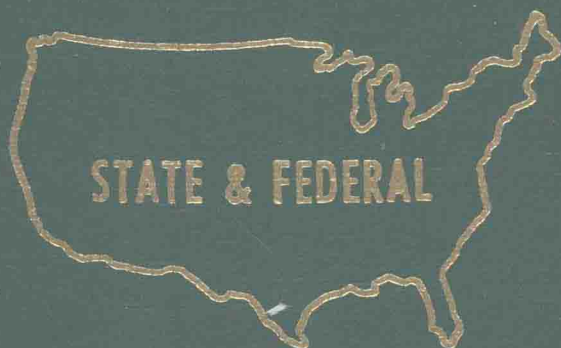

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FOREWORD

A rewriting of the article PARDON AND PAROLE has been necessitated by several landmark United States Supreme Court decisions relating to parole, which have been handed down since the publication of the original article in 1971. The most significant of these decisions established the conditions under which a parole statute creates a liberty interest protectable under the Due Process Clause of the Fourteenth Amendment, the due process requirements for determining whether to grant parole once that liberty interest is created, the due process requirements that must be met before parole may be revoked, and the conditions under which a parolee is entitled to counsel in parole revocation proceedings.

Largely because of those Supreme Court decisions, a significant body of case law has developed at both the state and federal levels dealing with the validity of parole procedures and the rights of parolees and prospective parolees, which is reflected in the revised article PARDON AND PAROLE. The revised article also includes new discussions on the Uniform Act for Out-of-State Parolee Supervision and the liability of parole authorities for harm caused by parolees.

The article PARENT AND CHILD has been updated to reflect the large amount of litigation in that area since publication of the original article. Of particular note is the discussion on the tort liability of a parent to a child, an increasing number of jurisdictions having recently recognized the right of a child to sue his or her parent in tort.

The articles PARKS, SQUARES, AND PLAYGROUNDS and PARLIAMENTARY LAW have also been updated and rewritten.

The article PARTIES takes into account a large body of recent case law, particularly with respect to class actions, standing to sue and third-party practice, and to reflect the use of more modern terminology in some areas.

The entire article PARTITION and the part of the article PARTNERSHIP which originally appeared in Volume 59, will appear in new Volume 59A. This arrangement allows for complete coverage of the subject of partnership in one volume.

Research References are provided to forms and other practice aids found in other publications in the Am Jur family (Pleading and Practice Forms (Revised), Legal Forms 2d, Proof of Facts, and Trials), the TCSL® federal services (Federal Procedure, L Ed, Federal Procedural Forms, L Ed, and USCS), the ALR system, and law reviews. In addition, the following four-bar features designed to help the practitioner are included:

■■■■ *Observations:* point out opportunities that are not obvious or comment on trends or ambiguities in the law.

■■■■ *Cautions:* flag pitfalls that may result in the imposition of liability or result in procedural defaults.

■■■■ *Recommendations:* provide plans for action.

■■■■ *Practice guides:* provide detailed procedures for proceedings before

administrative agencies and courts, as well as suggest some advantageous strategies.

■■■■ *Form drafting guides*: provide detailed instructions for the drafting of pleadings.

The **Table of Statutes and Rules Cited** and **Table of Parallel References** are contained in the front of the volume, and the **Index** for all of the above topics is located at the end of the volume.
