HOW TO USE

A. Contents of the Service

This Service provides the main NSW Summary Offences legislation and the Justices Act with annotations. The Justices Act deals with the administration of criminal law in NSW's Courts of Petty Sessions whilst the Summary Offences legislation contains most of the minor criminal offences in NSW; these offences are mainly prosecuted in the Courts of Petty Sessions. Several other Acts, Regulations, etc, incidentally affect the working of these Acts, eg the Bail Act, the Coroners Act, the Rules under the Justices Act and so on. Where relevant this legislation is included in the Service. All relevant court forms are included and there is a special section providing specimens of informations for use under the Summary Offences legislation. The scope of both sets of legislation is surveyed in separate introductions.

Because this area of the law is the subject of much change and high use, the information in this Service will be updated quarterly, thus keeping subscribers regularly up to date with the most recent statutory, judicial and practical changes.

B. How to use the Service

The Service has been organized on the convenient paragraph system. Every section, regulation and form published has been allotted a paragraph number; eg a section of an Act might be allotted a paragraph number [1028]. Where there is commentary on a section or regulation, that commentary has been allotted a point paragraph number connected to the relevant paragraph number of the relevant section; eg a comment on a section to which the paragraph number [1028] has been allotted, may be given the point paragraph number [1028.1].

The paragraph numbers in the text appear sequentially, starting from paragraph [101]. There are, of course, gaps between some paragraph numbers to allow for future comment and expansion of the Service. To make it easier for subscribers to use the paragraphing system the numbers of paragraphs appearing on a page appear on the top line of that page.

There are two ways to find information on your particular topic.

(1) The case approach — If you have the name of a case you can find commentary on that case, and related cases and topics, by using the Table of Cases which is behind the "Contents, Index and Tables" Guidecard.


(2) The Statute approach — Similarly, if you have the name of the Act, go to the Table of Contents behind the "Contents, Index and Tables" Guidecard. This Table will direct you to the Guidecard and page number. If you turn to that page you will find a complete list of the sections or regulations of the Act to go with a paragraph number.

C. Loose Leaf Servicing

The loose leaf format of this service enables constant and rapid up dating of all the material contained in it.

At quarterly intervals Butterworths will mail replacement pages, together with simple and straightforward filing instruction asking you to remove existing pages and insert new pages as soon as you receive it. (These filing instructions always appear at the front of each issue.) By doing this you will ensure that your service is always up to date; if you let service issues pile up before filing, pages can be lost, and your service will become unreliable.

D. How to File Replacement Pages



Follow these steps:

- (1) Press the binder catch ("a") inwards to open the binder flat.
- (2) Refer to the filing instructions (see specimen, next page) and take out the retainer bar ("b") with all the material that precedes the first page to be replaced or inserted.
- (3) Place the retainer bar containing this material ("c") to one side with posts upward.
- (4) Follow the filing instructions for removal and substitution of subsequent pages by removing the old leaves ("d") from the filing bar ("e") and place the new leaves ("f") face downwards on the retainer bar. (The old leaves should be placed to one side, face down, till step 7.)
- (5) Repeat the process for filing of the remainder of the issue, being careful to transfer each time from the filing bar to the retainer bar those leaves which are not being replaced.
- (6) Note that where an issue includes new pages for which there are no equivalent old pages those new leaves should be inserted in the appropriate place on the retainer bar, as indicated by the filing instructions.

HOW TO USE

(7) When the issue has been inserted, check the old leaves to see that every page designated for removal by the filing instructions has been removed, and that there are no pages of the current issue among them. These leaves should then be destroyed.

(8) Return the retainer bar (with new material) into position and clip on the binder release catch.
