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Preface

The purpose of this book is to introduce the reader to the fundamental principles and concepts which are Constitutional and Administrative Law. Given the size of this book, the treatment accorded to each topic cannot be exhaustive. However, it is hoped that students of Public Law will find that it provides them with the core of the subject.

These are fertile times for anyone with an interest in Constitutional and Administrative Law. The present Labour government has introduced a number of important changes to the constitution since its election in May 1997. Devolution has taken place in Scotland and Wales, and the machinery exists for its operation in Northern Ireland. The hereditary basis of the House of Lords has largely been removed as the first step in the process of reforming the second chamber. The rights contained in the European Convention on Human Rights can now be pleaded before domestic courts as a result of the passage of the Human Rights Act 1998. With all these initiatives taking place, along with others, such as legislation on Freedom of Information (which is not covered in this book), the Public Law student has much to command his or her attention. Accordingly, although I have endeavoured to state the law as at 1 January 2000, events will necessarily require that the reader supplements his or her knowledge of some of the topics covered by keeping a watchful eye on the press and legal journals.

There are a number of people that I would like to thank for their help and assistance in writing this book. Nicola Padfield, the Core Text series editor, for agreeing to let me loose on this title. At Butterworths, the commissioning staff for their patience and understanding and the editorial team for their quick and efficient handling of the manuscript and page proofs.
