DAY DELEGATION

Introduction

This year my Vanderbilt colleagues, Dr. William Schaffner and Dr. Allen Kaiser, have not only done the lion's share of this work for which I always take the credit, they even put our section to bed in my absence! At the deadline I was in Africa, learning about AIDS firsthand. So, to my sorrow, I have missed our wonderful yearly intellectual feast and I am the

poorer for it.

It startles me nowadays to realize that I've been doctoring for more than 48 years. I cannot conceive of having another career. It has been all that I hoped it might be. During those years I have witnessed my share of profound human tragedy and suffering, and those experiences have shaped me. But, my encounters with those who have AIDS and progressive HIV infection have been different than any I've had heretofore, and they seem to weigh more heavily on me. I hate this disease and what it does to people with a passion. Never before have I found a malady so relentless and unforgiving, and never before have I found it so hard to relieve the suffering, both physical and emotional of those afflicted.

The speed with which sophisticated science-based knowledge has been marshalled regarding this unwanted visitor has been absolutely breathtaking. It has more than justified what we have invested in biomedical research since the 1950s. But, I also understand the anger and despair of those who wish us to move even faster. Although their rage has often been aimed at inappropriate targets, it has dramatized the urgency of the need to mute or turn aside this disease that now promises us a catastrophy of cataclysmic world proportions. I have said elsewhere that AIDS has put a spotlight on many of the things we don't do well in our world society. We have trouble tolerating those who are different. We have trouble designing flexible systems of care that are swiftly responsive to changing patient needs. We have trouble creating simple human support services that include shelter, food, or friendly nonjudgmental attention to one another. We need to feel more comfortable about spending for human infrastructures that build and support people—not midgets.

I see some signs—some encouraging signs—that AIDS is making us think about such things. Clearly, superb science contains the ultimate hope: a really good antiretroviral drug and a wondrously different vaccine. Science will do this, if not next year, then the next, or the next. But, in the interim, to strive for a kinder and gentler world is neither a foolish nor a trivial objective. Anything that can soften the agonies imposed on

people by this illness would be welcome.
