## PREFACE TO THE FOURTH EDITION

Many decisions have been reported since the last edition of this book went to press, and the body of learned commentary on the Theft Acts and on the rather unhappy case law on the 1968 Act has continued to grow. This edition has been thought necessary to take account of these routine developments; the previous edition had come to have a decidedly out of date appearance.

I have taken the opportunity to refer, at many points, to Professor Glanville Williams' remarkable treatment of the subject in his *Textbook of Criminal Law*, which appeared shortly after the previous edition went to press; and I have occasionally ventured to respond to his arguments. The offences under the Theft Act 1978, formerly relegated to a stop-press type of Appendix, are now, of course, raised to the body of the text. A good many passages of the book are substantially rewritten; some are entirely new; and there has been a good deal of reorganisation. It would be tedious to try to itemise the changes. I mention only the fact that I have been able to take account of the Court of Appeal's decision in *McIvor* (on the issue of dishonesty), which was reported just after work on the proofs was, as I thought, completed. In consequence I can express the hope that the book will be found to be up to date to November 18, 1981.

Looking back at earlier Prefaces, I see that I have omitted to thank the publishers for relieving me (as they have consistently done) of the task of preparing the index and tables. The truth is that they do so out of self-interest; there are departments in which they are confident of their authors' incompetence. It is a nice question in ethics whether gratitude can be earned by a self-interested act. Happily it is a question that I need not resolve. I have had much else in recent years for which to be grateful to my friends at Sweet and Maxwell Ltd. This I record here with pleasure and without qualification.

I wish also to thank my secretary, Barbara Harris, for all her cheerful help in the preparation of this edition.
